An **initiative** (e.g. methodology, project, process or technique) carried out under one of the programme's topics:



Research & Innovation



Low-carbon economy



SME Competitiveness



Environment & resource efficiency



<u>Good</u> practice: potential for learning and inspiration

### Why submit your GP?

**Good quality** information needed!

### **Great communication opportunity**

- Display project GPs on your website
- Give visibility to the content of your cooperation

## Source of inspiration and learning for European policymakers

 GP may be part of good practice database (validated by Policy Learning Platform experts)

### Why submit your GP?



### Progress reporting support

- Part of reporting task → submit GPs identified
- Policy officers validate number & overall quality of GPs → indicator 'number of good practices identified'

- Quality more important than quantity:
  - → Submit GPs with real added-value for partnership

### Who can submit a GP?

 Member of Interreg Europe online community





- Project partners or stakeholders who identified GPs during exchange of experience
- Anyone with a GP which fits the programme definition



### Who can submit a GP?



- Important: ideally the GP owner fills in the form Please pass this info to your partnership!
- User profile of the GP author is linked to GP





- If your organisation is not in charge of GP, indicate the relevant organisation in the form
- Your contact details are still linked to the GP

Remember: Name & contact details of GP author visible to members of online community only

Submit GPs any time before last progress report of phase 1

### Solution to the exercise

GP n. 1 Contracting: Policy Academy Wiesbaden, Hessen

Maybe – to be improved (not self-explanatory title, confusing and unclear information on the main sections, no responsible organisation)

GP n. 2 "Fix the city"- City problem registry platform & application

Maybe – to be improved (resources needed not indicated)

GP n. 3 Manufacturing high-quality pasta respecting tradition & improving local agriculture sustainability

No - to be removed (private initiative with no possibility of public intervention)

### Common pitfalls

- No link to project topic
- Not actually a good practice i.e. is a report on project progress
- Not already implemented i.e. refers instead to a theory or proposal
- Main features of practice not described in enough detail
- Evidence of success not described in measurable quantitative/qualitative terms
- Initiative from a private company & unclear what a public authority could learn from the practice
- No reference to financial resources, staff numbers, equipment etc. needed
