






## How to get there?


## From the airport


- By taxi: Arrival from **Athens International Airport** is 30 min drive to the venue (see on the map below)
- <u>By metro</u>: Line 3, Metro station: PANORMOU (ΠΑΝΟΡΜΟΥ) (see on the metro map below) . Direct line from the airport 35 min



#### From central station

- <u>By taxi</u>: President Hotel is at 20 min drive from the Athens Railways Station. (see on the map below)
- <u>By metro</u>: Line 2 change at SYNTAGMA station (ΣΤ.ΣΥΝΤΑΓΜΑΤΟΣ) and then take line 3 until Metro station: PANORMOU (ΠΑΝΟΡΜΟΥ) (see on the metro map below)
