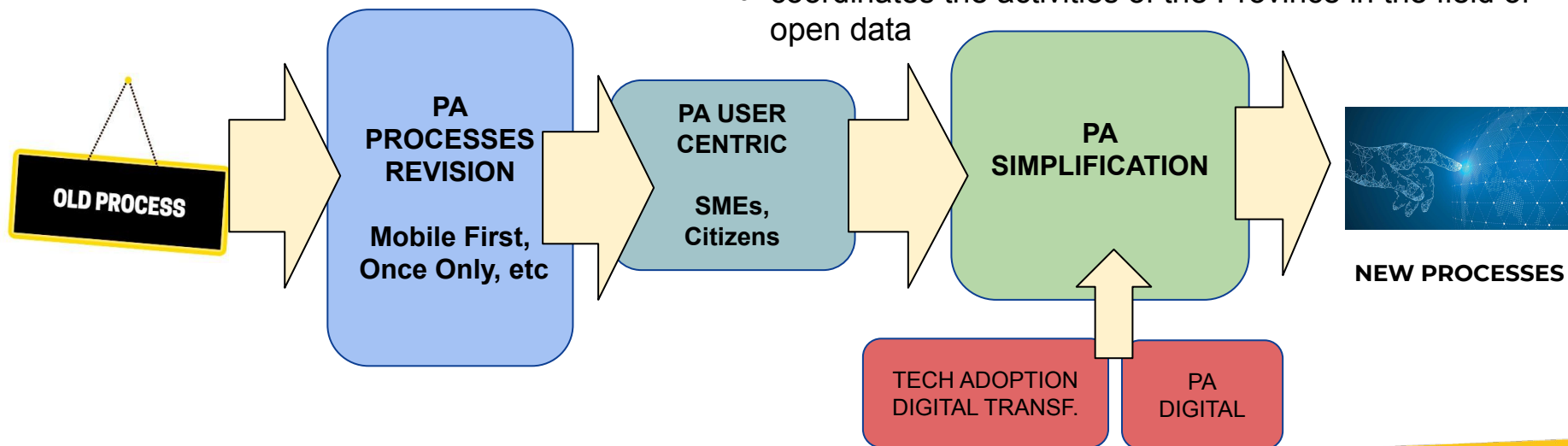
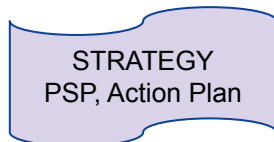
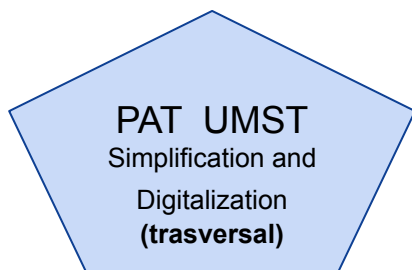
The themes of **simplification and digital transformation are strategic** and of pervasive importance, and the Province is a lever for a public administration that acts as an **agent of innovation** and facilitator/aggregator of relations with the other public administrations and within the public administration. A public administration with an **organization that is closer to the needs** of businesses and citizens and more effective in making all involved, both public and private.

This means reviewing administrative processes, designing and implementing high-quality and **easily accessible digital services** modeled on the needs of the recipients, introducing new organizational models **enabled by the responsible use of digital technology**, investing in the development of skills and the digital culture.

The Province has defined an **operational framework with actions for the three-year period 2020-2022**, aiming at the achievement of concrete and tangible results also through the sharing and implementation of several interventions

It is essential to frame the involved complexity - even technical - of the theme and inside the articulated relations between the province administration with the local entities of the territory that determine the digital transformation itself

# PAT Simplification and Digitalisation Strategic Mission Unit (



- promotes administrative simplification and reduction of bureaucratic burdens
- accordance with national and European guidelines, use of ICT policies as a tool to improve relations with citizens and businesses
- coordination of strategic initiatives regarding digital administration, dematerialisation of processes and documents and the transition to digital
- analysis and rationalization of processes, use and dissemination of technologies internally and with users
- coordinates the activities of the Province in the field of open data

# Trentino Public Innovation System



- **Trentino Digitale Spa:** provincial in-house ICT company, under restarting both on a strategic and organizational level after the merging with Trentino Network, the public digital Trentino backbone. In addition to managing the commissioning and the governance of the projects, shared technical sites have been developed in the last year;
- **FBK:** important scientific and operational collaboration activated in 2018; common work on issues of relevance and impact including the management of the transition to the Cloud;
- **University of Trento:** some specific activities are grafted into some relevant PAT projects, including (Public Works, Distance Learning);
- **Provincial Health Agency:** close collaboration starting from 2018, joint governance of some decisive issues including the interoperability of data and data center projects;
- **Hub Innovation Trentino:** Provincial innovation Agency;
- **Trentino Sviluppo:** Provincial Development Agency;
- **Trentino Municipalities Consortium:** association of all municipalities, collaborate with Province on some common projects, diversified actions on transversal projects;
- **Municipality of Trento:** important technical collaboration on the theme of digital transformation and convergence of the entity at the PAT-FBK working table;
- **Team Italia Digitale:** (national level) under the prime minister office, active relations on various fronts in operational testing
- **AgID:** (national level) constant and operative relationship with the contact persons of the Agency and with other territorial RDTs

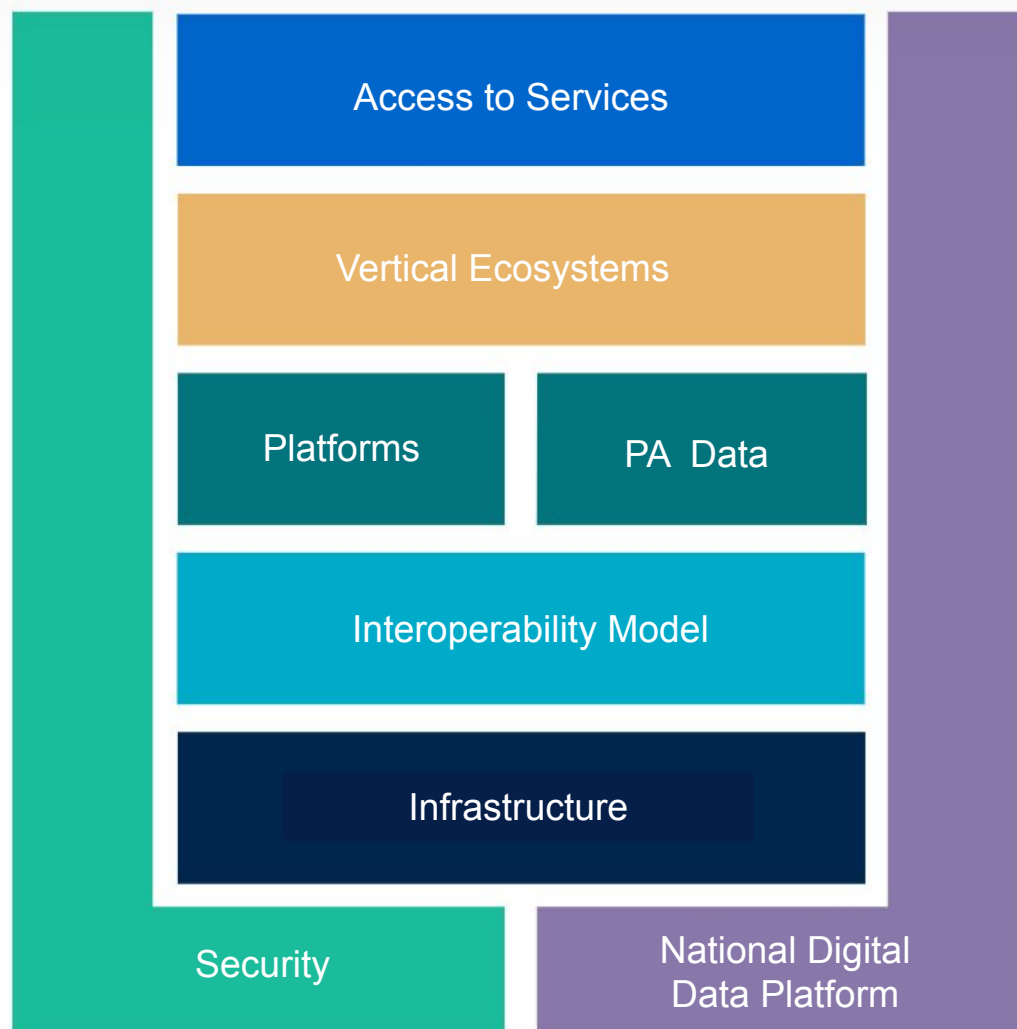

# Reference Architecture Model



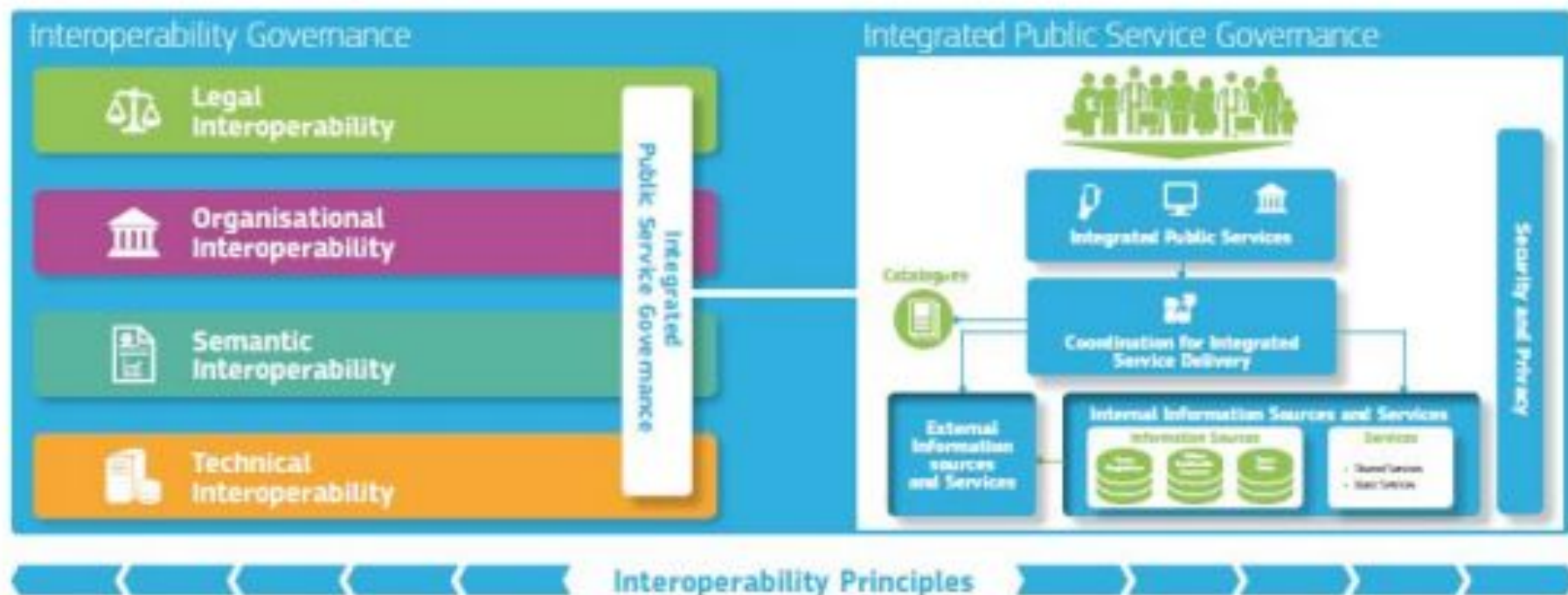

# Transition to digital



- Review processes through re-engineering and digitization procedures
- Design and implement quality digital services that are easy to access and modeled on the real users/businesses needs
- Introduce new organizational models enabled by the new technology
- Invest in development of digital skills and digital culture
- Promote the logic of the single point of access
- Extend the digital grow of the territory providing enabling control and protection services for people to use the digital infrastructures
- Exploit the potential of AI and (big) Data

# Simplification for businesses



- Reduce information and bureaucratic burdens through the use of self-certification and acquisition (once only principle) improving data/application interoperability and digital forms standardization.
- Mapping productive sectors to assess the interaction between the different levels of government and reduce overall PA response times.
- Rationalize or reduce, where possible, the controls on companies (proportional to the inherent risk in the activity)
- Simplification/digitalization of the complex procedures concerning manufacturing, services and building activities in the logic of the EU Single Digital Gateway (SDG).

# Open data



- Highlight and increase the value of public information assets (e.g. base registries, datasets, informations) to facilitate integration and the development of innovative services.
- Orienting open data efforts towards genuine and effective data interoperability.

# Digital Transformation



*Digital platform availability, empowerment of users*

- Alignment of the **provincial digital strategy with the national** (Piano Triennale Informatica) and the European Digital Agenda
- Providing a **unique common authentication node** (SPID/CIE/eIDAS) to be used by all local and provincial PA
- Providing unique **online PA payment node** (MyPay) at provincial level
- Evolving the provincial **online services portal** towards EU Digital Single Gateway: num of services available, aggregating the other digital services, align services description to EU/national standard
- Favor the **adoption of cloud and mobile-ready** digital solutions and systems
- Favor the **onboarding in the national civil registry** (ANPR) and the overall adoption of the ANPR in the development of new services
- Endorsing specific events/activities to **improve digital awareness** of citizens and businesses in the province



# Simplification for Businesses - 1



## *Single Register of Provincial Control Activities (RUCP)*

Allows all required structures of the Province, as well as its instrumental bodies, to jointly planning the future “control activities” on businesses and to share with each other data relating to the results online.

It allows and integrated strategy that acts simultaneously on the regulatory data and on the rationalization of the institutional system, which intervenes on the techniques used to perform the control, orienting it towards a perspective of greater efficacy and efficiency and a wider transparency. Its of the checks carried out, reducing and simplifying the administrative burden over businesses

- Co-designed with businesses and PA
- Integrated with other services (Cantieri web)
- Mobile ready
- Integrated with ext base registres
  - Parix - Chambers of Commerce;
  - Accredia - quality certifications) to give extensive information about companies and their characteristics.

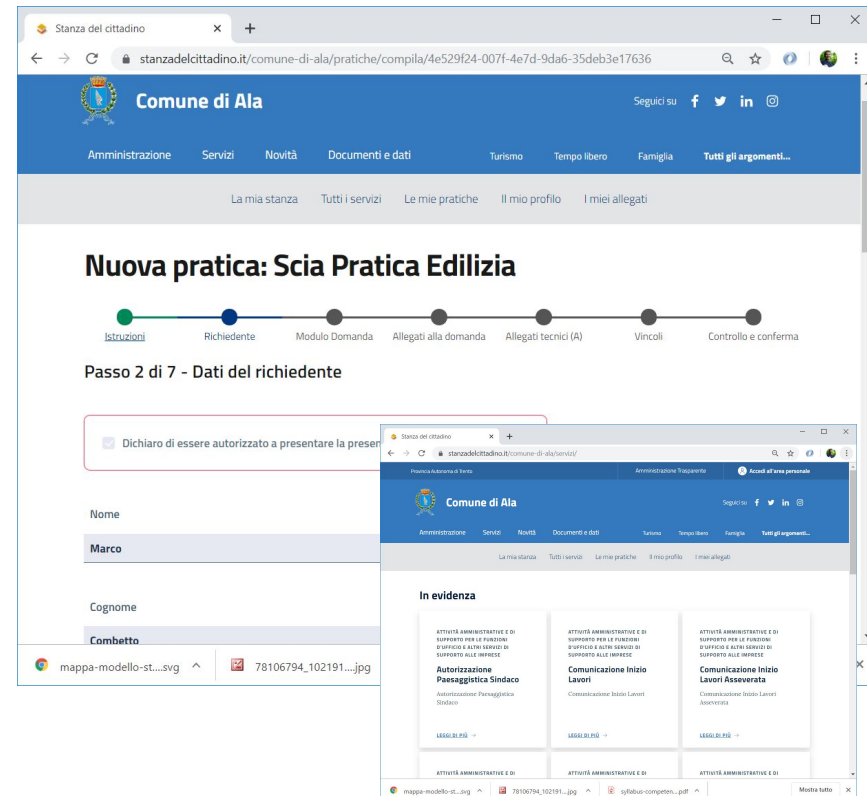


## New services: PEO Online Building Permit

- TN Digitale for the enabling platforms (SPID/CPS, MyPay/PagoPA).
- Early adopter of the new UX framework Bootstrap Italia

- Designed with Design Italia kit
- Open source and ready for reuse
- Interoperability model guidelines
- Implemented in the cloud
- Opendata-ready

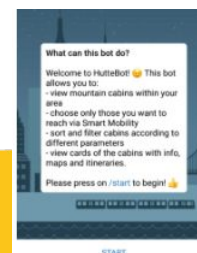

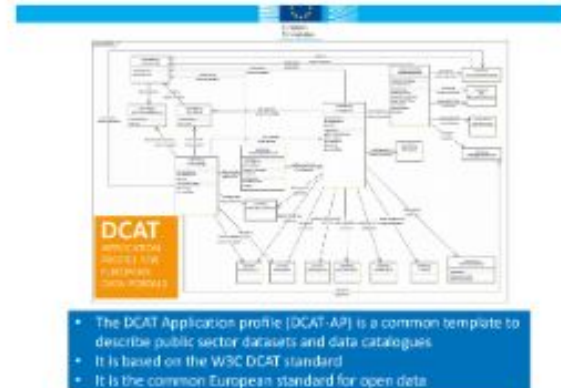
