





RIS3 Key Policy Trends





About RIS3



- Smart Specialisation is a place-based innovation policy concept to support regional prioritisation in innovative sectors, fields or technologies through the entrepreneurial discovery process (EDP), a bottom-up approach to reveal what a region does best in terms of its scientific and technological endowments.
- RIS3 aims to address some common issues that regions face when drafting their regional innovation strategies such as:
 - the picking winner syndrome,
 - the lack of understanding of the regional institutional context,
 - and the copy-paste imitation of innovation policies designed in best performing/leading regions.





- Monitoring acts as an early warning system through selected indicators on prioritisation, the Entrepreneurial Discovery Process (EDP), and the implementation of the overall strategy.
- Indicators have to be realistic, relevant to each region, and results-oriented (and easy to collect).
- Monitoring is a key activity for re-defining priorities and a first step towards deeper evaluation. Monitoring promotes better RIS3 evaluation.

Evaluation can be conducted at different stages of the policy cycle:

- Ex-ante evaluation: it provides useful information to improve the intervention logic of the S3 at the initial design stage.
- Process (implementation) evaluation: it provides useful insights on policy developments to policymakers to amend their strategies.
- Impact evaluation: it aims to identify the effect of the policy intervention on socio-economic outcomes.
- Evaluation promotes better RIS3 design
