

Interreg Europe in a nutshell








European framework for biowaste

- Waste Framework Directive requires a separate biowaste collection or recycling at the source by 31 December 2023
 - Door-to-door collection, collection points, home composting
- Further supported by target to recycle 65% of municipal waste by 2035
- Biowaste treatment must result in material recycling (via anaerobic digestion and composting)
