Policy Improvement



- Learnings from INNO Industry GPs from Slovenia and Portugal
- New regional financial support scheme for digital transformation of companies launched in June 2020: Digi4SME - since Nov. 2020: Digi4Business
- Enlarged target group incl. service sector
- Simplified, faster application process: jury meetings every 2 weeks, official project approvals every month, application form: 2 pages only.
- Output: ca 1200 project applications since June 2020
- Impact: a lot of new companies reached, far beyond the « usual suspects »





- Put needs of SMEs at the centre (not technology)
- Incentivise cooperation of stakeholders in your Digital Innovation Ecosystem
- Build on existing competencies within your region and connect to complementary competencies beyond
