- 2013: S3 work started
- Regional S3 documents and whitebook prepared
- Results came slowly...
- Comission feedbacks, changing requirements
- 2014 summer: assigned gov. commissioner,
  - New action plan
  - NUTS-3 level approach
  - Synthesis of regional S3 documents
- 2014 autumn: extended NUTS-3 level workshops (2x19)
- End of 2014: national S3
- RDI strat: RDI system problems and weaknesses
- OPs: financial frameworks
- S3: industry focuses

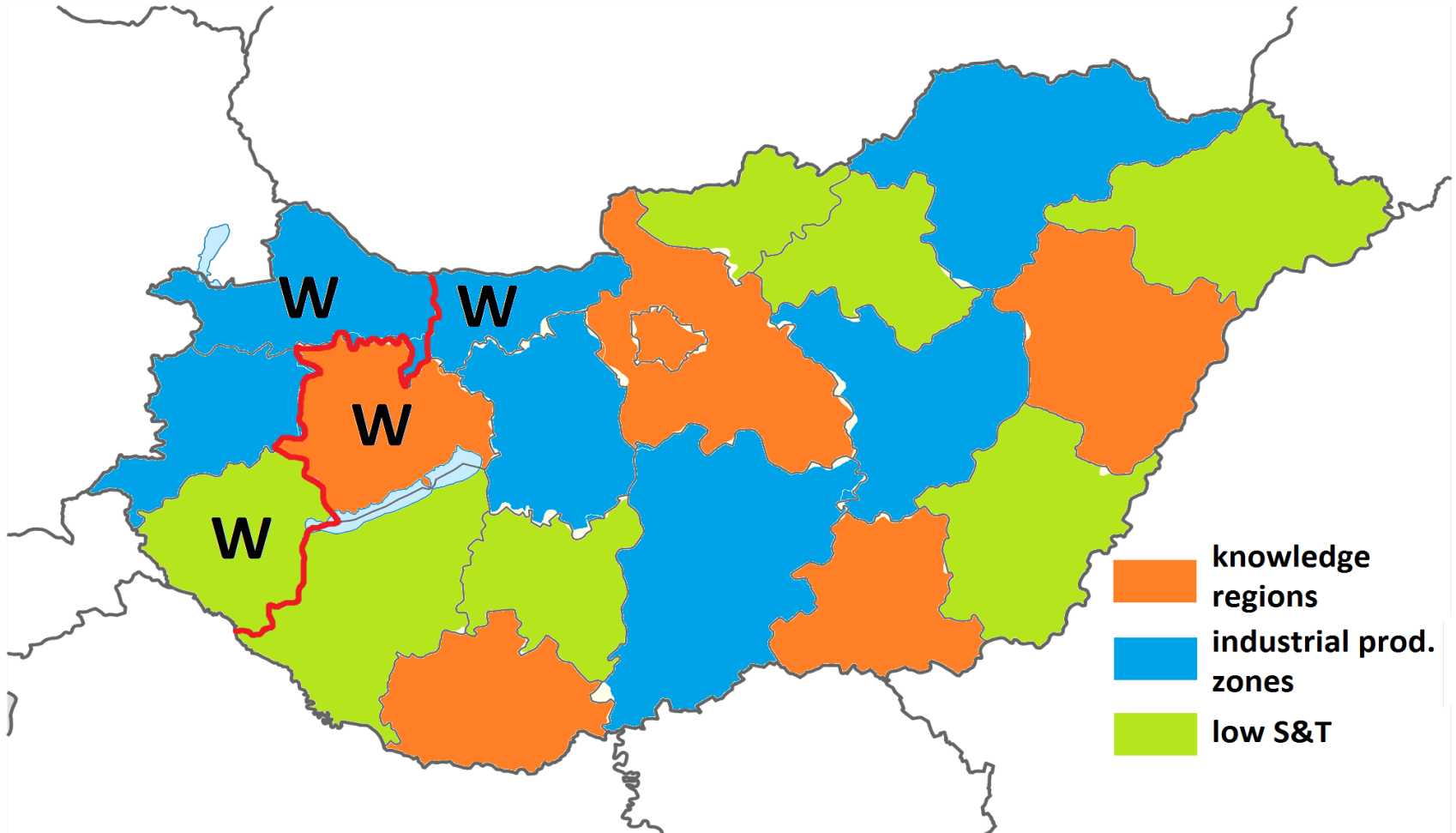

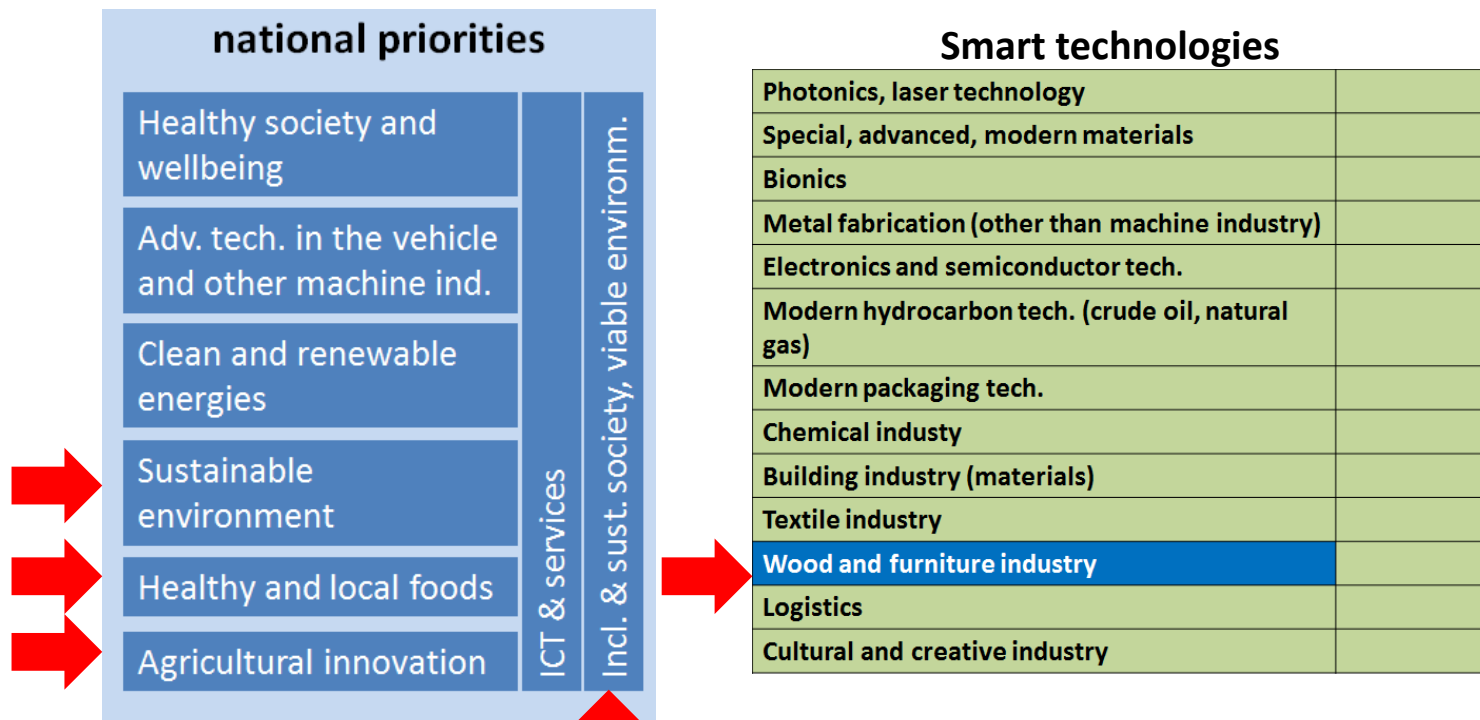

# QUESTION 1 Is there a project pipeline agreed for the bio-economy development niche?

- No.
- EDIOP priorities: no industry focus

## QUESTION 2 Are there criteria for funding /co-funding RIS3 business projects? If yes, what are they? What type of investments do they prioritise?

- Yes. EDIOP priority 2: **R&I**
- S3 entry criteria for the projects in the R&I priority:

2.1.1	Projects demonstrating their fit to S3 obj.s <u>are eligible</u>
2.1.3	Projects demonstrating their fit to S3 national priorities or smart technologies <u>get priority</u>
2.1.4	
2.1.5	No S3 criterion
2.1.7	No S3 criterion*
2.2.1	Projects demonstrating their fit to S3 national priorities or smart technologies <u>are eligible</u>

## **QUESTION 3 Do the criteria for funding / co funding RIS3 projects, include eligibiltiy of innovation partnerships (R2B or B2B, or R2R)**

Yes.

- In terms of project size:
  - Small calls: no consortia, (0-30/150k €)
  - Medium calls: consortium is optional for applicants (-1,5/3M €)
  - Large calls: consortium is optional or sometimes a must
- In terms of objective of the call partnership is ensured by:
  - Consortia (R2R, B2B, R2B)
  - Contract between R&I buyer and seller → voucher (R2B)
  - Capital investment contract (B2B)



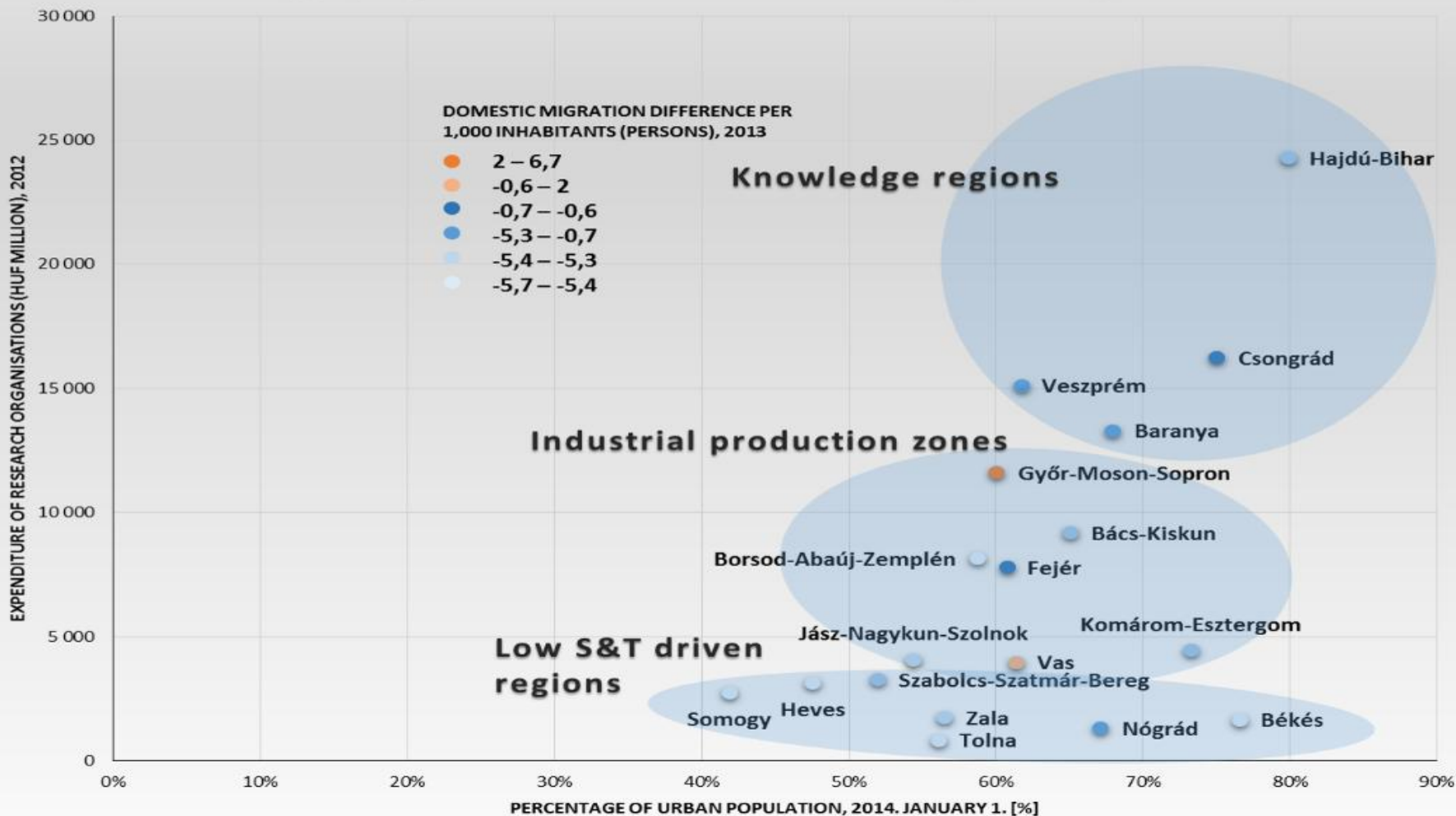
## **QUESTION 4 What type of RIS3 related investments & innovation partnerships have already been fund/co funded? Are there some results already?**

- No information available on the submitted projects in term of the selected S3 priorities.

## **QUESTION 5 Is there an innovation infrastructure already assigned with supporting the RIS3 implementation? If yes, are there performance criteria set to this structure?**

- Yes: S3 is implemented by financing the S3-relevant projects.
- Applicants present their project fit to S3.
- **Inter-ministerial WG:**
  - NRD Office: coordinates the process, pre-selects projects, checks the relevance/fit of each submitted projects to the S3.
    - External experts evaluate the S3 fit of the project
    - 2nd check: Managing Body: policy objective fit
  - Managing Authorities
- **Local/county level working groups: companies, NGOs, gov, science: defined and will reconsider S3 priorities**
- **National level steering board: coordination, monitoring (distribution of projects)**
- **No performance criteria.**
