**– everyone's right to
cultural heritage**

“...cultural heritage is a group of resources inherited from the past which people identify, independently of ownership, as a reflection and expression of their constantly **evolving** values, beliefs, knowledge and traditions. It includes all aspects of the environment resulting from the **interaction** between people and places through time;”

UNESCO

– Intangible cultural heritage

practices, representations, expressions, knowledge and skills

- Oral traditions
- Performing arts
- Social practices,
- traditional legal systems;
- traditional games;
- kinship and ritual kinship ceremonies;
- settlement patterns;
- Traditional craftsmanship etc

In late September 2015, the UN General Assembly decided on the new global goals for sustainable development, known as Agenda 2030. The new agenda has 17 goals ranging from education to sustainable cities.

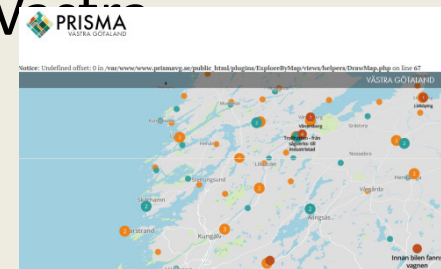
Among other aims:

- Preservation of heritage and culture and sustainable development are important themes.
- Convention on the protection and promotion of the diversity of cultural expressions
- Affirming that cultural diversity is a defining characteristic of humanity,

Västra Götaland (& Göteborg) - Regional Culture Plan 2016-2019

Issues concerning intangible cultural heritage:

- **Prisma** a digital platform for industrial history in Västra Götaland, with focus on children and youth



- **”Hantverkslaboratoriet”** the arts and Crafts laboratory as a national centrum for crafts and intangible heritage



- Planing strategies for **climate changes** and the impact on cultural heritage



- Middle class housings in urban environments,
- Castles and mansions,
- Trade (eg. banks and trading stalls),
- Judiciary (eg. courthouses and City Hall) and staff residences (eg. parsonages).

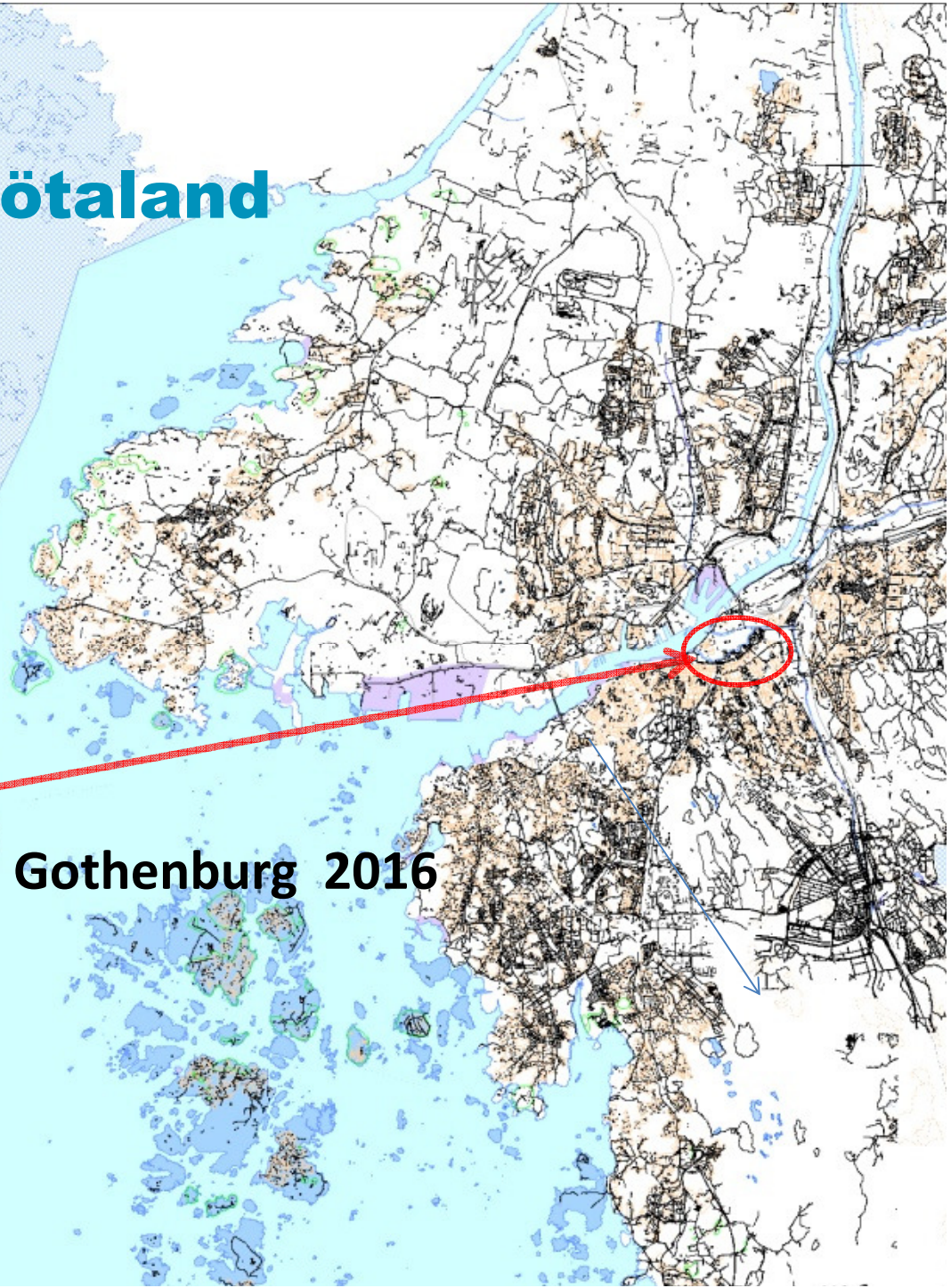
A recently started process for modern heritage could result in so much as hundreds of new monuments in the region (20th century architecture)

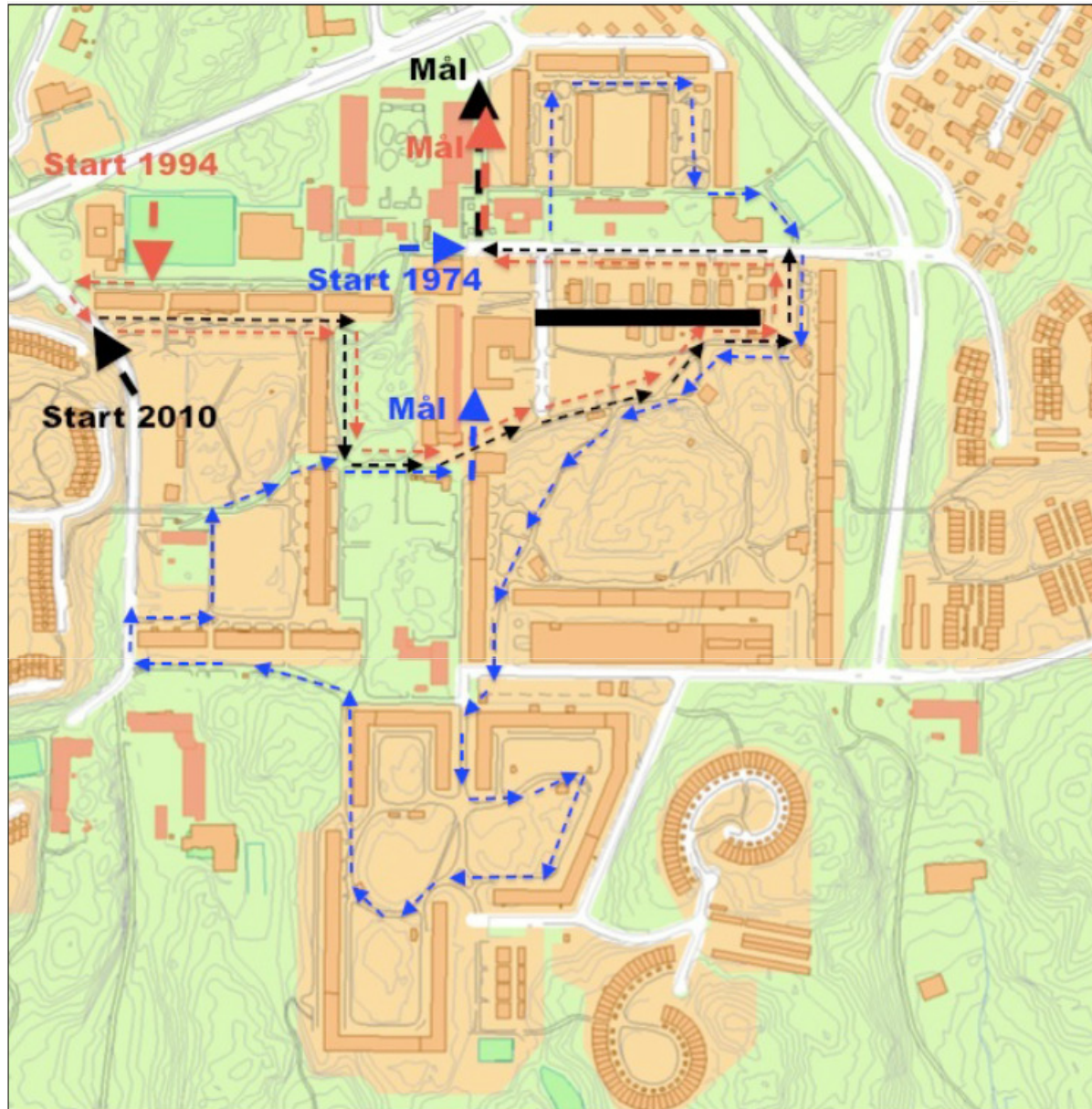
