Hungary - Parents' House, a civil franchise approach

Awarded "Best Practice" by the **European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions** and by The **World Bank**, headquartered in Washington, in 2014 the Parents' House delivers a national civil franchise network addressed to connect civil players with the government and business sectors. Founded in 2007 by social politician Judit Regős, Parents' House applies mainstream social business model including the venture (70-80% of revenues), the local



government, the state (support and tenders) and the business sector (CSR-based cooperation) in Budapest.

Italy - I.RE.NE., a network of social enterprises for growth

The cluster "I.RE.NE." has been created with the aim of consolidating and promoting models and patterns of social economy among SMEs, spreading the culture of corporate social



responsibility and sustainable development and fostering cross-sector interaction processes and the emergence of crosscutting sectors. Securing an investment of around 2.600.000 euro in five years, I.RE.NE. has increased its membership from 196 to 240 organizations and thus, has become the most influential regional platform for the growth and the reinforcement of the social innovation system and civil economy in the Abruzzo region by now.
