The Lombardy policy in bioeconomy

Within SmartPilots, Innovhub SSI addresses the following policy instrument:

Programma operativo nell'ambito dell'obiettivo "Investimenti a favore della crescita e dell'occupazione" in Lombardia 2014-20 (Operational Program – OP – in the framework of the "Investments for growth and employment" – Lombardy 2014-2020)

The OP of Lombardy focuses on three main goals in order to implement a regional strategy coherent with a "smart, sustainable and inclusive" growth:

- 1. Set the Region back on a sustainable growth path
- 2. Increase system productivity (both private and public)
- 3. Increase companies' competitiveness

Range of funding	min. 25.000 € - max. 65.000 € per project (60-65% of total costs)			
Rules	De Minimis regulation			

Innovhub + Fondazione Cariplo (not ERDF Funds)				
Aim	Promote integrated research among industry and research organisations – focus on bioeconomy and industrial biotech			
Tool	Grants			
Beneficiary	Research organisations + companies			
Range of funding	Max. 330.000 € per project (60% of project's costs)			
Rules	Research prganisations based in Lombardy + companies from whole country; 40% to be covered by own resources

Tool Mix of soft Loans & Grants

Beneficiary At least 2 companies from 2 different participating countries coordinated by an SME; also research organisations can participate

Range of funding 60% for SMEs (loans)

Rules 1 call per year; funds linked to countries' availability

Technological Innovation Fund (not ERDF Funds)

Mix of Loans & Grants

Aim	Support industrial research and experimental development

Beneficiary Companies based in Italy

Range of funding 50% (loans) + 20% grant

Rules Research organisations can participate with a limited budget









Direct/indirect support mechanism (National level)

Industry 4,0 (2017-2020 National Plan)				
Aim	Strategic measures to stimulate private investment in Industry 4.0; bio-based economy is expressively mentioned			
Tool	Hyper and super depretation; tax credit;			
Beneficiary	Companies and SMEs			
Range of funding	50% tax credit			
Rules	Different according to tools			

CONCLUSIONS

- No special funds available for pilots plants (neither at regional nor at national level)
- Possible combination of different initiatives
- Main focus on SMEs
- At the moment few biorefineries in Italy created through private investments
- Possible involvment of Regional Government for inclusion of dedicated tools among the existing programmes (i.e. vouchers scheme)
