

Warm & Well: The Finances

Currently funded through:

- 1) Local Authority Core Funding
- 2) Referral fees from installers
- 3) Ad Hoc national Government initiatives
- 4) Energy Company Obligation





Warm & Well: Public Awareness

- Signposting by Public Bodies
- Doctor's surgeries/ Social Prescribing
- Age UK
- Citizen's Advice
- National and Occupational Health Referrals
- Local Community Groups (Mother and toddler/Dementia etc.)





Warm & Well: Approach

- Accessing free impartial energy advice Severn Wye Energy Agency
- Access to local, regional and national grants
- Home visits (Average identified savings of €425p.a.)
- Home improvements through EE Installers

Targets vulnerable people at risk of:

- Fuel poverty
- Health problems
- Financial problems





Results of Warm & Well...

> 80,000 calls since 2001 – now averaging 3,000 p.a.

>40,000 households assisted with in excess of £30m of home improvements
Only approx. 10% of this from householder contributions

Capacity enabling – Our delivery mechanism exists for current and future opportunities to support those in most need.
