





# Best practices from FEA: IBM Restarting Microcredit

#### Basic data

- Launched in 2002
- Promoters:
  - FEA
  - Local Government of Székesfehérvár
  - IBM Storage Products Ltd.
- Geographical coverage: City of Székesfehérvár
- Two part:
  - intensive (2 year, who were IBM emplyees) the IBM microcredit team have part in the decision
  - second (4 year, fund for microcredit activity) –
     competible of the EU Recommendations time period (short, medium, long) of the sustainability, socail impact,

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## Objective

- In 2002, the closure of the IBM manufacturing plant in Székesfehérvár affected 3700 people.
- Profile of the company: manufacturing hard disk drives - less demands on the market



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# Objective

- The closure of the plant affected approximately 10.000 people in Székesfehérvár (families included)
- The aim of the Local Government, FEA and the IBM itself was to ease the employment crisis
- Provide an efficient tool for the employees to restart their career as entrepreneurs.







### Explanation of the initiative

- The IBM Restarting Microcredit was an initiative of FEA and the Local Governement of Székesfehérvár as a reaction to the closure of the IBM manufacturing plant.
- A separate fund was set up, with the donation of the Local Government and IBM (IBM donated 1 million EUR )
- Goal: Helping redundant employees to become entrepreneurs.
- Fund manager was FEA







## Availability of the local credit

- FEA created a refundable, thus recyclable loan product
- Resulted in the outplacement of total 2,2 million EUR to 178 clients.







### Target group

- Former IBM employees wishing to set up an enterprise
- Microenterprises employing such former IBM employees could also apply to this credit.







#### Innovative elements

- Quick reaction to the crisis
- Set up of an efficient tool capable of mitigating the negative effects of the collective redundancy
- cooperation of the local government, the company and the local LEA
- IBM evaluate the program process and the results highly appriciated
