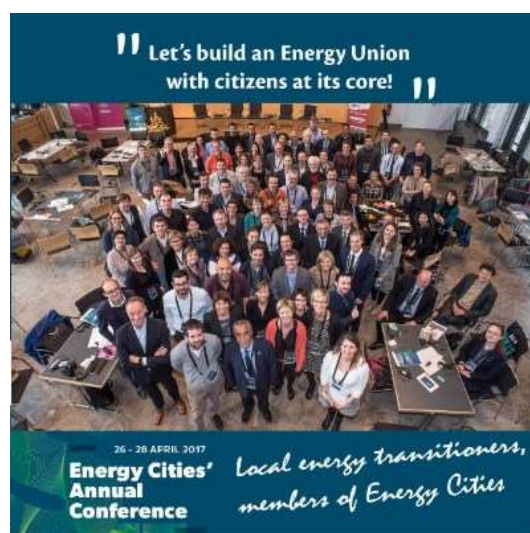


Around the project
