## Curriculum vitae

Francisco Cárdenas Ropero holds a degree in Chemical Sciences from the University of Barcelona, specializing in Biochemistry. Likewise, he has a diploma in "Creation of Models in Ecology and Environment", by the Polytechnic University of Catalonia, and another diploma in "Statistics of Data Processing" by the University of Barcelona.

His professional activity began in 1982, as professor of mathematics, physics and chemistry at a public institute in Barcelona, to later become director, until 1992. This year he began to work in the Generalitat de Catalunya, first in the Sanitation Board of the Department of the Environment, as technician of the Information Area; Then, with the same charge, in the Waste Agency; And finally in the Urban Environment Area of the Department of the Environment, as a technician. From 1998 to 2000 he was technical adviser in the urban planning area of Barcelona City Council, coordinating the European Project "Information, Competitiveness and Sustainability in the Urban System". From the year 2000 to the present, he is the Head of Programming and Planning of the Urban Ecology Agency of Barcelona.

He has coordinated several research projects focused on the ecosystem analysis of the city, at the local, state and European level. He has coordinated local projects on noise, air pollution, the water cycle, energy, diversity, mobility and urbanism. He is the author of more than 40 scientific-technical articles in the urban environment, and he coordinates local, state and European research.
