Aristotle's Park in Stagira





Aristotle's Park

- The Aristotle's Park, a unique theme park of Halkidiki, is located at an altitude of about 500 meters, in the historical village of Stagira
- The park preexisted and the wonderful location was chosen in 1956 to host the statue of Aristotle, in honor of the great philosopher who was born in Ancient Stagira
- The unique interactive **instruments** were placed there in 2003: experimental instruments, operating by rules of physics that are mentioned in Aristotle's textbooks. With this addition, the park has become a favorite destination for every visitor and school, since it combines recreation, entertainment and education. It is estimated that has more than 15.000 visitors during the summer.

Aigai- The Royal Metropolis of the Macedonians

- One of the most important archeological findings in Greece
- Museum of Royal tombs of Aigai
- The most important finding is the famous larnaca with the incinerated remains of Philip II, father of Alexander the Great, bearing the sixteenth sun (or star) -the symbol of the Macedonian dynasty
- The archaeological site of Aigai is protected by UNESCO as a world cultural heritage monument and a site of outstanding natural beauty.

Archeological Museum of Pella

- The new museum of Pella began its operation in 2009, in order to project the great excavation findings of the area in a modern building.

The Ancient Theater of Dion







Dion

- A place long sacred to the ancient cult of Olympian Zeus
- Dion became the official religious center of the Macedonians in the 5th century BC
- Alexander the Great offered splendid scarifies at the sanctuary of Olympian Zeus before embarking on his Asian campaign
- Archeological Park: the Dion archeological site covers roughly 150 hectares.
- Archeological Museum: the exhibits are organised according to where they were found.
- The web site offers an on-line virtual tour.

- The Archaeological Museum of Thessaloniki attracts visitors from around the globe and welcomes them with information leaflets in 20 languages.

- In the Museum the visitor can visit the 11 galleries of the permanent exhibition and can travel back to the world of Byzantium through thematic sections concerning the daily private and public life, worship and the burial customs, architecture and art, the commercial and business activity. He/she can discover the continuity and the relationship between past and present.
- Being a pioneer in the treatment of its exhibits, as well as its activities and the high level of the provided services, all equally treated, the Museum, The Museum of Byzantine Culture has been awarded the Council of Europe's Museum Prize for the year 2005.






State Museum of Contemporary Art

- The State Museum of Contemporary Art was founded in 1997 and has been steadily and dynamically developing, since then. Today, it is one of the most prominent foundations that hosts and projects works of modern and contemporary art.
- Apart from the Costakis Collection, which includes 1.275 masterpieces of prominent Russian Avant Garde artists, the State Museum of Contemporary Art has in its possession a significant amount of paintings and sculptures of Greek and foreign artists (about 200), which were donated by the Thessaloniki Cultural Capital of Europe 1997 Organization.
- The State Museum of Contemporary Art particularly emphasizes on its educational role. Organized educational programmes follow the contemporary museum educational methods and aim at bringing students of all ages in contact with its permanent collections as well as with the museum's periodically organized exhibitions for children.


Macedonian Museum of Contemporary Art

- The Macedonian Museum of Contemporary Art is the first modern art museum founded in 1979 in Greece. It covers all areas of modern art.
- The Macedonian Museum of Contemporary Art organizes educational programs on periodic exhibitions and permanent exhibitions, and also devotes programs and other arts. With the help of museum guides, tens of thousands of children have enjoyed learning about art. It also offers guided tours and, in the framework of EU programs, it collaborates with other museums to develop educational programs for adults.
- Virtual Museum-The purpose of the virtual MMCA is to create consistency between its exhibits, visitors and various levels of information about its context, expanding its activities to new potential participants in the museum experience and increasing the participation, education and entertainment of its visitors

- Educational programs aim through interactive and experiential actions to transform cinema into an alternative learning and knowledge tool.


Thessaloniki Museum of Photography

- The Technology Museum holds 3 permanent exhibitions:
- 1. The <u>Classic Cars exhibition</u> featuring cars classified as "milestones" of automotive technology. Meet special exhibits to compare the trends of the past with current or future designs.
- 2. The <u>Technopark</u>. A hands-on area for all. The visitor takes part in an interactive journey of the world of Physics. Everyday life experiments and examples from electricity to magnetism, mechanics, optics etc. A fun adventure to begin with.
- 3. The <u>Ancient Greek Technology exhibition</u> Samples of technological innovations and works of Ancient Greek inventors. Reconstructions based on written evidence of the everyday life, constructions, naval engineering, measurements etc.






Thessaloniki 360° Edition application
