### REGIONE EMILIA-ROMAGNA

The Local Stakeholder Group of Emilia-Romagna Region met, for the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting, on 11 July 2017, at the Department for Research, Innovation, Energy and Sustainable Economy, in Bologna.

12 people participated, as representatives of the following:

The meeting started with a detailed analysis of the Mapping Methodology proposed by the lead partner, sharing opinions and feedback.

Stakeholders provided their inputs and suggestions on both the 2 phases of the mapping activity.

During a fruitful and open discussion, the various ideas and proposals have been matched, by producing the tables required in the Mapping Methodology.

Firstly, participants agreed on the sectors to be included in the mapping and, then, identified the main bodies involved in cultural and creative policies in Emilia-Romagna, considering the various administrative levels. The “Table of competences per administrative level (Mapping 1)” was produced, with a focus on the regional administrative level and the Municipality of Bologna.

Afterward, stakeholders discussed about the regional ecosystem around CCIs, including support policies and tools, stakeholders involved and services provided. A first draft of the “Territorial table of support measures and tools available per stakeholder (Mapping 2)” was sketched.

Finally, stakeholders agreed to meet again for discussing in detail about the selection of regional good practices to be proposed.
