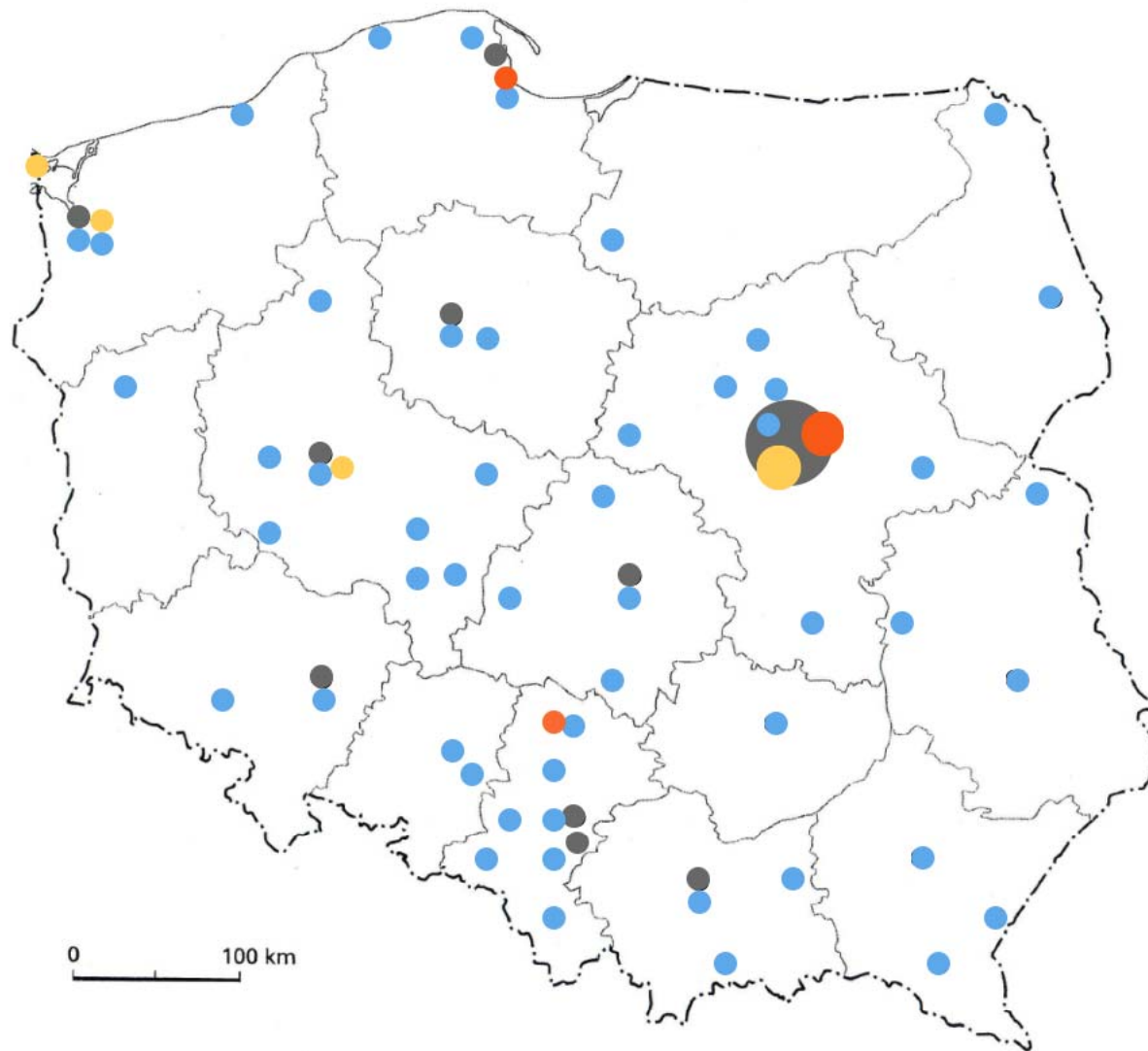

The high level of the event is guaranteed by an honorary patronage of Ministry of Development and Warsaw's City Hall

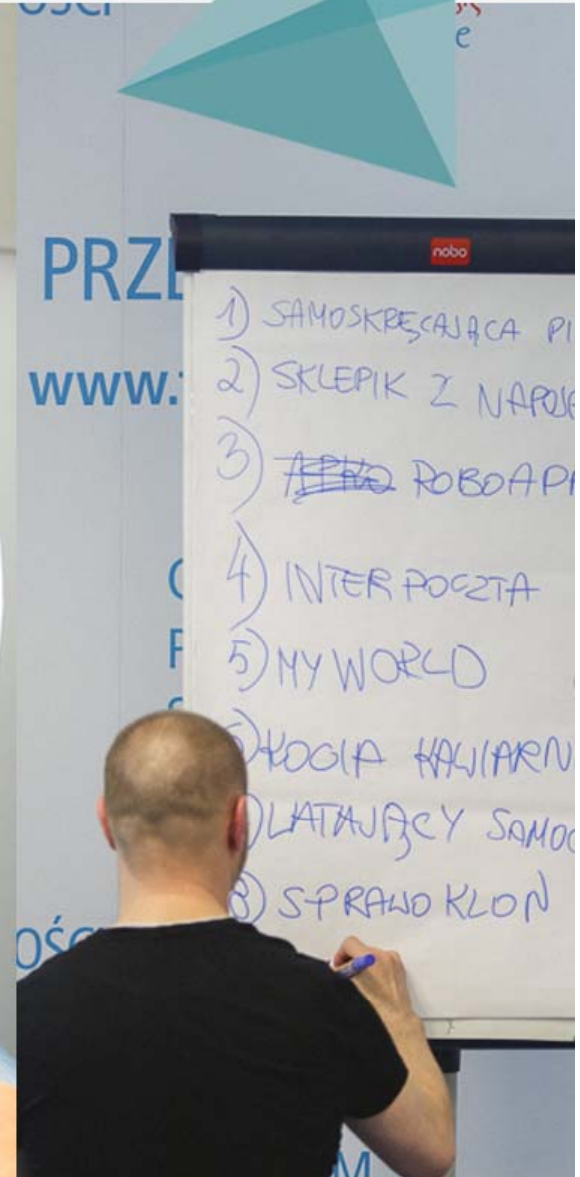
Forum is also one of the most popular startup events in Poland, which gathers approximately 200 young entrepreneurs on the spot and 15 000 online viewers
