

Visit to Conference Centre of MAICh on 8th September 2017

During the second day of the meeting, on 8th of September 2017 a tour visit around the Conference Centre of MAICh took place, where partners and stakeholders had the chance to see three different installations of solar semi-transparent photovoltaic systems with a total power of 13,8 KWp that contribute to the decrease of CO2 emissions due to energy use. In the first skylight, 120 units of thin film panels have been installed with a total power of 4KW covering a total area of 86 m2 of the skylight.



In the second skylight 32 units of monocrystalline panels have been installed with a total power of 5KW covering a total area of 41 m2 of the skylight.







In the third installation 20 units of polycrystalline PV panels have been installed with a total power of 4,8KW covering a total area of 45 m2 of the skylight.



All those PV installations generate around 12,000 KWh per year, covering part of the Conference Centre's annual electricity needs.
