

## Visit to Conference Centre of MAICh on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2017

During the second day of the meeting, on 8<sup>th</sup> of September 2017 a tour visit around the Conference Centre of MAICh took place, where partners and stakeholders had the chance to see three different installations of solar semi-transparent photovoltaic systems with a total power of 13,8 KWp that contribute to the decrease of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions due to energy use. In the first skylight, 120 units of thin film panels have been installed with a total power of 4KW covering a total area of 86 m<sup>2</sup> of the skylight.



In the second skylight 32 units of monocrystalline panels have been installed with a total power of 5KW covering a total area of 41 m<sup>2</sup> of the skylight.



In the third installation 20 units of polycrystalline PV panels have been installed with a total power of 4,8KW covering a total area of 45 m2 of the skylight.



All those PV installations generate around 12,000 KWh per year, covering part of the Conference Centre's annual electricity needs.
