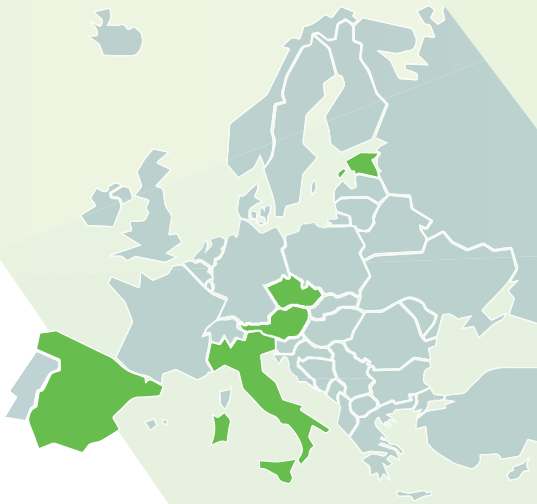

EMAS as a Nest to Help And Nurture the Circular Economy

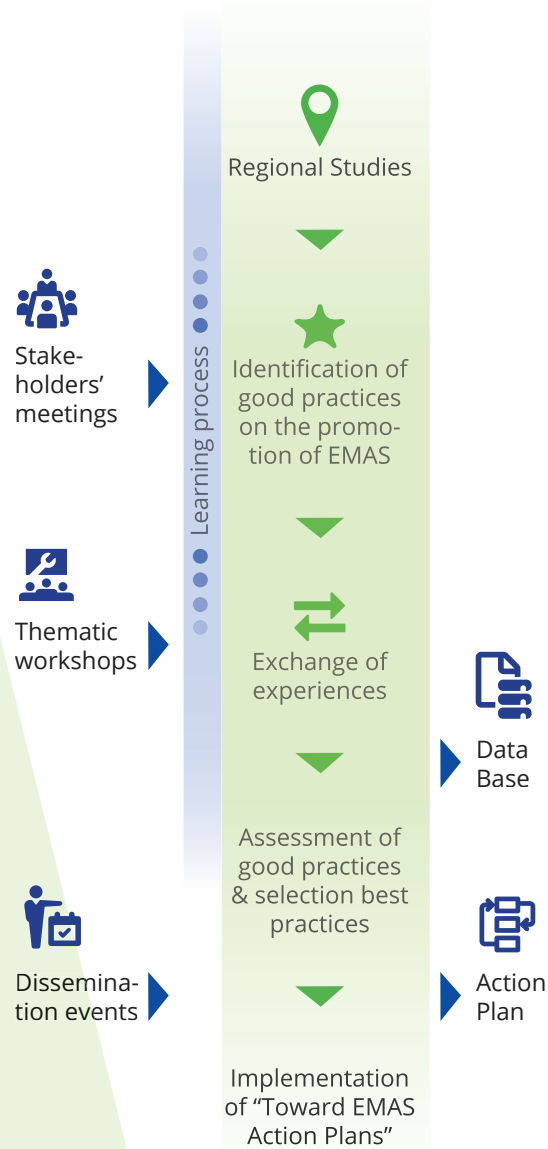

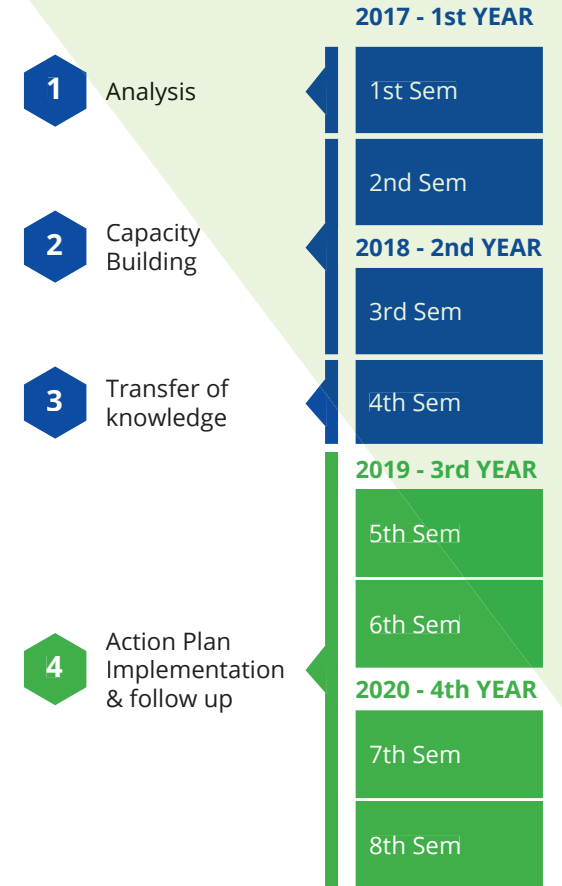
