Objectives of the event

The third Interregional event of Enerselves project took place in Brussels on the 20th June 2017 during the EUSEW, the most important European happening organized by the EC on RES and EE. It's been organized to present the participants the project partners' policy instruments targeted by Enerselves. Since the project's objective is to promote new policies, or improve existing policies to support the integration of RES in buildings for self-consumption funded by Structural Funds and other EC tools, the EUSEW represented the ad-hoc place where to present Enerselves.

Workshop

The Government of Lazio Region (Italy) organized the event hosted by the Region of Świętokrzyskie (Poland) and supported by the Extremadura Energy Agency (AGENEX). The event's objective is to disseminate information on the project's goal to a widest audience as possible, taking advantage of the great deal of stakeholders at EUSEW. Over 40 people among partners and stakeholders from the partner countries participated to the event. During the event all the project's partners made a presentation of their organization and the policy instrument they have identified as target of Enerselves. It was opened by the welcome of the Head of the Representation Office of Świętokrzyskie Region, followed by the Agenex that dedicated its presentation to introduce the Interreg Europe Programme and the Enerselves project by describing objectives, outputs of both and the calendar of the activities. The Lazio Region presented the tools and programs that will be impacted by the Enerselves project and analysed the state of the art of the regional call for proposals 2.0 that will finance interventions for energy efficiency and the increase of RES use in the public buildings.

The North-East Regional Development Agency of Romania briefly described the energy policies and resources at national level with a detailed description of the existing solar parks and wind projects in the country. Finally, Mr. Ovidiu Savu, the project manager also analysed the forecast evolution of the capacities of renewable energy in Romania by 2030. Mrs. Katrine Svensson from the Energy Agency for Southeast Sweden introduced the organization's goals and activities in their region as well as their contribution to the country's objectives in sustainable energy.

Furthermore, she described the Agency's commitment to the Enerselves project objective and their collaboration in other projects. Mr. Jesmond Xuereb, Director of MIEMA (Malta) introduced the Malta Intelligent Energy Management Agency's background, activities, networks and projects. He also described the Gozo's main problems and identified the project's stakeholders. Finally, the Region of Sardinia presented the activities of the Regional Agency for social housing indicating the different sources of funding used to finance sustainable energy projects in the building sector including the most innovative such as Jessica (European Funds of EIB).
