EURELCO is delighted to announce that on the 5th of October 2016 the Interreg Europe project COCOON was officially approved. Following the granting of EU Horizon 2020 <u>NEW-MINE</u>, this is **the** second flagship EURELCO project, corroborating the increasing attention for (enhanced) landfill area magained target and mining. The interest Europe project COCOON on policy of Ladmin Management is coordinated by i-Cleantech Flanders and unites 8 partners from 6 EU regions. With a budget of 1,4 million euror the COCOON partners will improve regional policy on Landfill Management in 6 regions, starting from existing regional legislation, and learn from the best practices and lessons learned in the other regions.
