The following topics were discussed during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Internal Meeting of ANEL.

What has been done by now:

- **ANEL represented HoCare Project** in several **European Events** such as:
  1. Smart Regions, Helsinki (June 2017)
  2. Interreg Europe Policy Learning Platform Event, Milan (October, 2017)
- **ANEL arranged a number of meetings with the Managing Authority and the Head of Department of Nursing Services (Ministry of Health)** to discuss about the improvement of the identified (in the AF) Policy Instrument. It has been decided to proceed with the initiation of a new project that will be funded in the framework of the specific PI aiming at introducing innovative ICT services in Home Care. This new project should embody elements included in the Good Practices identified in other HoCare partners' areas.

Two representatives of the **Ministry of Health (Department of Nursing Services)** attended the three International Thematic Workshops (Madeira, Budapest, Litija), organized under the framework of the HoCare Project, in order to exchange experience and understand how these Good Practices work and what suits better in the case of Cyprus. They assessed the available Good Practices and decided to proceed with **EkoSMART – eCare**.

**EkoSMART – eCare**, which was promoted by the Slovenian partners of HoCare project, was the chosen one among other Good Practices that have been presented during the three International Thematic Workshops mentioned above. The Ministry of Health is interested in applying a project based on the main philosophy of EkoSMART and more specifically its part concerning “Smart Integrated Healthcare and Long-term Care System” (eCare).

- Preparation of the **Joined Thematic Studies** (Percentage of Work Done (POWD): **70 %**)

- Finalization of the Joined Thematic Studies
- Preparation of the Policy Transfer Reports
- Preparation of the Action Plan
- New Project: **EkoSMART – eCare** - Proposed steps / steps to be followed:
  - A) Prepare and submit the project fiche for approval by the e-Government Committee of Cyprus.
  - B) Prepare and submit a technical document to the MA for including the new project under financing through the selected PI (oral confirmation already granted in the presence of the President of Cyprus)
  - C) Arrange a study visit in Slovenia in order to analyze in detail the technical specificities of the GP and then to adopt in local environment accordingly
