09:30 – 09:45h Welcome and introduction

09:45 – 10:15h Presentation of the results of the Action Plan of realization of Strategy of CCI's
Development for the period 2016-2017 in the Slovak Republic

- The Action Plan contained 37 specific tasks that implementation was from 2016 to the end of 2017. The aim of the Action plan was to stimulate creativity, to develop a creative environment and to focus on the systemic and cross-sectional perceptions of the creative economy as an integral part of the national economy, including the premise that culture is not only identity but also prosperity. *Overview of priorities and measures:*
 - PRIORITY NO.1: EFFICIENT SYSTEM FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE CREATIVE INDUSTRY
 - PRIORITY NO. 2: QUALITY HUMAN RESOURCES
 - PRIORITY NO. 3: INCREASING THE ABSORPTION MARKET CAPACITY
 - PRIORITY NO. 4: SUPPORT FINANCING INSTRUMENTS

11 of these tasks were completed, 5 of these tasks were not completed, and 21 are still in progress. The main problems of the implementation of the Action Plan were identified in its evaluation and next steps were also set such as yearly monitoring of the tasks still in progress and creating a new Action plan.

10:15 – 10:45h Presentation of the current state of the CREADIS3 project

- The study visit in the Slovak Republic held on 20. - 21. March 2018 was the first study visit organized in the framework of CREADIS3 project's activities. The general theme of the study visit "Foster multi-level administrative collaboration across the territory to enable better synergies between the different authorities in charge of CCI's" was identified in accordance with the specific sub-objective for the Slovak Republic within the project's objective. The

sub-theme of the visit was chosen by the co-hosting partner according to the same criteria (Public Service of Wallonia) and presented „Policies and tools to support the development cross-sectoral cooperation in the cultural and creative industries“. These two main topics was mainly addressed on the second day's main event, that was focusing on the theme Supporting multilevel cooperation and policy development in the field of cultural and creative industries consisting of two workshops lead by hosting and co-hosting partner.

- Other activities included the finalizazion of the first outputs of the project such as Mapping 1 and 2 and Report on Territorial Diagnostic.
