- SADECO is in charge of producing local policies and protocols for waste management in Cordoba; following the framework established by the regional authority with the chance of locally improving that frame.

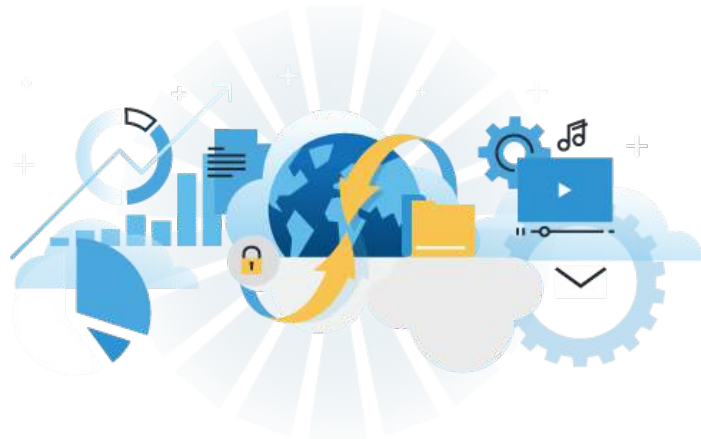

# Andalucia: LfM Policy Instrument

**ERDF Operational Programme 2014-2020 for Andalucia.**

Priority Axis 6- environment & resource efficiency



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**Investment Priority 6a “Investment in waste sector”**

**Specific Objective 6.1.1:** Development of separation and treatment, including actions for cycle closure, both management plans and investments in infrastructures: clean points, transfer stations, treatment plants and **landfills**.

Due to the generic character of the OP in measure concerning landfills, many different type of projects on the topic can be implemented.



# Andalucia: LfM Policy Instrument

Currently, with our stakeholders, **potential actions contributing to policy improvement are being identified:**

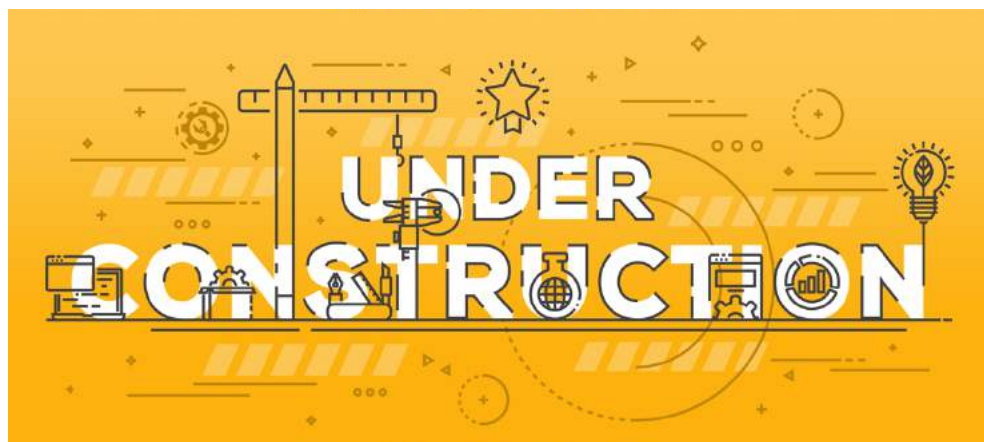
- Definition and entrance into force at regional level of a **discharge tax**. It would prevent discharging in landfill. Funds collected reinvested in landfills.
- Definition and entrance into force of an **index of impacts** and a **clustering of landfills** according to this characterization regarding impacts. Funds would be distributed on the basis of the characterization.
- **Green procurement** being extended. Contributing to prevention of waste, recycling and reuse.
- **Responsibility of the producer widened**. This is regularly done for packaging but it should reach the rest of products.



# Andalucia: LfM Policy Instrument

**However we think it is still an early stage of project:**

Further discussion in the local group about potential policy improvements and the learning of more importable practices through thematic seminars to come are being expected before taking decisions on PI improvement.
