# Minutes

The ICI project partner responsible welcomed the stakeholders to the meetings addressing 10 big questions after the presentation of HoCare project status and results during the half part of semester 3 and part of semester 4 and a short presentation of opportunities offered by Operational Programmes as financial support for health care applications. The experience of this project was shared with potential new applicants from quadruple helix stakeholders for Interreg Europe programme, for other topic of interest in applied research. The participants were acknowledged about HoCare interregional thematic workshops results, about the three Interregional HoCare Policy Thematic studies, about the three Interregional HoCare Policy Transfer Reports, about newsletters, videos and general information on project website and on Interreg Europe Programme. The meeting addressed 10 questions and each stakeholders expressed their concern and conclusion.

Management authority experts for the policy instrument Competitiveness Operational Programme 2014-2020 expressed their interest in the content of the HoCare project and considering the indicators to be fulfilled by Romanian Partners it was stressed that the improvement of the policy instrument could be considered for the next exercise the same operational program as regard the consideration of good practices to be transferred to Romanian context.

The stakeholders and experts from the Health Ministry, Management Authority of Competitiveness Operational Program and Ana Aslan Foundation International, were open to be part of the Action Plan Implementation and as the project had planned the last stakeholder meetings in 2 weeks after a HoCare consortium last meeting of Phase 1, they confirmed their interest and openness to participate in the 4th Stakeholder meeting to discuss the HoCare Action Plan for Romania.

The Romanian Academy stakeholder recommended the ICI team to increase the community of stakeholders in quadruple helix so that the involvement of SMEs in project sustaining innovation in health and home care for elders be more effective and based on COP opportunities

The present stakeholders agreed to continue interacting with HoCare Team and participate as experts during the phase 2 of the project.
