The participants were informed about:

- The results of the meeting in Tipperary, Ireland, 25-27 June 2018. There, the directives of the Western Macedonia Regional Action Plan were given, while the Lead partner asked also for the completion of the good practices soon.

The TEIWM external expert, with the support of the TEIWM team, has completed the Good practice and uploaded it to the Interreg Europe site. The sharing of all Good Practices among the partners is still pending.

In accordance also to the Action Plan directives that were given in the Ireland meeting, the Head of the MA-ROPWM, Mr Charalampos Kiourtsidis announced that the call for proposals for the RIS3 priority sector of Food and Drinks has been launched and closed already on the 3rd of September 2018. Therefore, there is no possibility for the SUPER project to change this policy instrument. Therefore, as also adopted in the meeting in Ireland, he proposed that the Action Plan for the case of Western Macedonia should focus on the RIS3 sectors of Energy-Environment and Tourism.

All the stakeholders agreed to the regional action plan orientation.
