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Recommendation #1

LEVERAGE POLICY IMPACT > FOCUS ON SMEs

- 🕒 So far RRI mainly addressing researchers
- 🕒 **SMEs represent 99% of all businesses in Europe** (up to 250 employees, no more than EUR 50 Mio./year)
 - 🕒 Wide **variety** within the group
 - 🕒 **Less structure & formalization** than large companies
 - 🕒 **Connected** in networks, clusters, value chains
 - 🕒 Embedded in particular socio-institutional **contexts**
- 🕒 **Societal Benefits & Business Opportunities**
- 🕒 **Promote multi-stakeholders actions,** therefore involving SMEs in policy dialogues

Recommendation #2

MAKE RI MORE TANGIBLE

- **Promote RI and its benefits** > the power of storytelling and peers [[Case Studies](#)]
- ④ Go beyond the normative aspects > make it an **operational framework** for small and medium businesses [[Self Check Tool](#)]
- ④ Provide **concrete guidance** on how to implement the concept into company practices [[Experts' papers](#)]
- ④ **Align RI requirements** with practices and standards that are already well established in certain industries (CSR; ethical requirements, etc.)
- ④ One size doesn't fit all > **targeted sectorial approaches** [[RI Sectorial Roadmaps](#)]
- ④ **Empower BSOs** to help SMEs embedding RI into their business strategies [[RI Labs co-creation method kit](#)]



Recommendation #2

MAKE RI MORE TANGIBLE



Company Management

This section includes questions on how Responsible Innovation is integrated into your company's systems and governance, including how you ensure that employees are empowered to facilitate Responsible Innovation.



Idea generation & research

This section will ask you about practices that your company follows at the beginning of an innovation, from idea inception and research to selection for further technical development.

For many SMEs with limited resources, it may be most important to invest in aligning these stages with responsible innovation principles, as the considerations of responsibility aspects in the initial stages of any innovation can make the greatest impact on responsible outcomes.



Development & Testing

This section covers all activities related to the development phase of the innovation process. It addresses decision-making about production, testing, and market entry. It also deals with the issue of safeguards from unintended negative effects.



Market & Impact

This section focuses on the final stage of an innovation process, when the innovation is launched and re-evaluated. For your company to be a responsible innovator it is important not only to conduct research and manage the innovation process responsibly, but also ensure that innovations, once on market, do contribute to solving societal challenges. It addresses the innovation's impact, company strategies for soliciting and integrating feedback, and the management of unintended or negative effects resulting from product/service.



Recommendation #3

INCENTIVISE RI IN SMEs

- ④ **Incentivise implementation of RI through funding criteria**, but make sure that the resources needed to apply for funding are not beyond what SMEs can afford
- ④ Adapt funding and regulation policy to **include RI dimensions**
- ④ Incentives to both **demand and supply sides**
- ④ **Provide funds/support measures for stakeholders engagement activities** (usually expensive for an SME) > investigate and stress the power of clusters and networks
- ④ Establish **RI accreditation schemes** > RRI Award to mark quality and excellence in RRI
