The MOLOC project team & partners wishes you a Happy New Year 2018!

2017 marked the launch of the MOLOC project, a first jump into the project!

A year focused on **mutual discovery** for the partner cities. Three meetings of the partnership in Lille (France), in Suceava (Romania) and in Hamburg (Germany), enabled all project teams to get to know shared challenges.

The **Torino** Urban Planning team emphasized the huge challenge faced by the city in the current revision process of the City Master Plan: still 5 million square meters of brownfields from automobile industry are to be reconverted.

Thanks to the MOLOC, the City of **Suceava** in Romania was able to launch its first **energetic audit on its public buildings**, a crucial step to modernise installations and reduce energy consumptions.

The Central Mining Institute, the Marshal's Office Silesian Voivodeship and the

Municipality of **Katowice** presented their actions regarding the fight against **air pollution**. Let us remind that this is a major issue in Silesia where 56% of the energy consumed originates from coal!

The City of **Hamburg** explained its **green roof strategy** while we were gathered on the green roof of the HafenCity University. In 2013, a total of 135 hectares of green roofs covered the city, around 2% of the total roof surface!

Lille insisted on its great results regarding **public lighting**, allowed by its ambitious investment choices. In October 2017, the annual electricity consumption was 47.4% lower than in 2004.

The 5 partner cities involved in MOLOC managed to involve a total of 56 local organisations in the project. These local partners will work hand by hand with the municipalities to design low carbon action plans for their territories.

On behalf of the project team we sincerely thank you for your involvement in 2017, and we hope to continue working with you in 2018!
