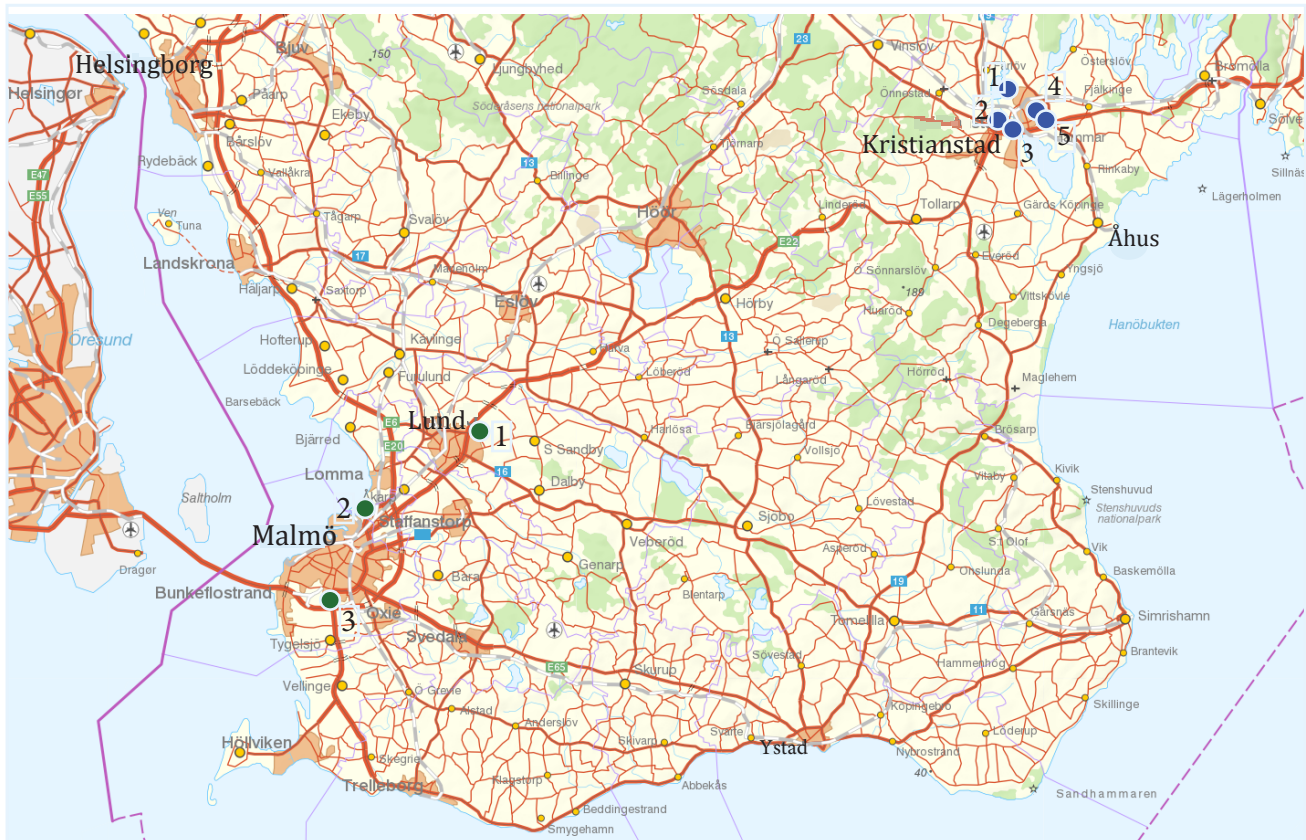

### Registration

### Transportation

There is an easy connection with direct train from Copenhagen airport (Kastrup) to Kristianstad C that takes about 1 hour and 15 minutes. Buy the ticket in the Skånetrafiken automat. The workshop will take place at the town hall next to the train station. The workshop ends on Friday after the excursion to Lund, Alnarp and Malmö and the participants are dropped at the station Hyllie in Malmö, 15 minutes from Kastrup airport by train.

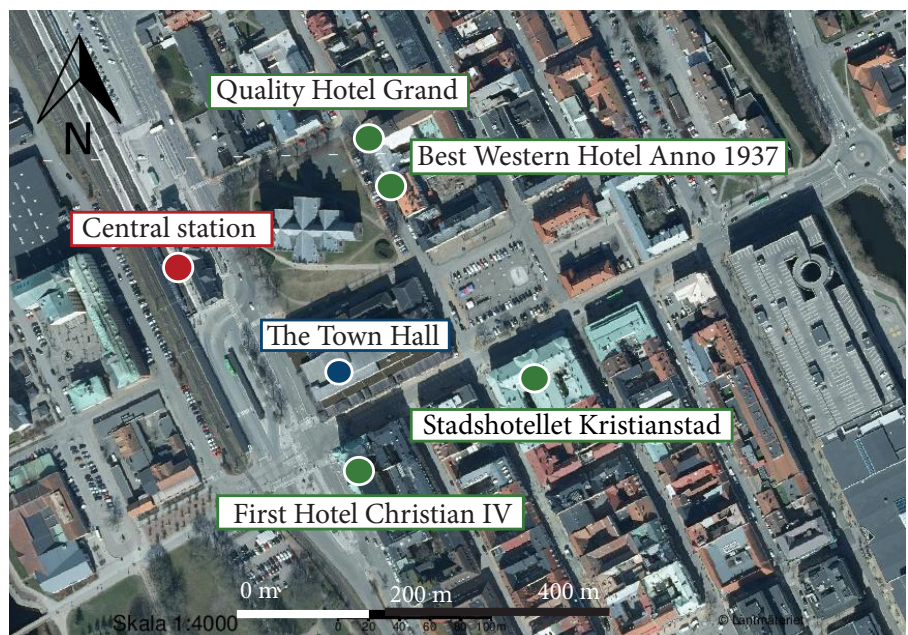
