Since the project is approaching the end of phase 1, dedicated to mutual and joint learning, the partners looked at joint challenges and drafted common policy recommendations for the regional, national and European level to bring forward cluster policies. The draft will be shared with CLUSTERFY but also other Interreg Europe projects related to clusters to identify common positions and together think and act stronger at European level.
