Ms. Dage from DG GROWTH put a focus on the broad variety of European cross-cluster activities for new industrial value chains supported by the INNOSUP program. A new concept to identify crosscluster synergies and new technologies was presented by Mr. Schneider from the Baden-Wuerttemberg agency.



In the round-table discussion of European cluster managers success stories and learnings on the disruptive potential of cross-cluster technologies and their very interesting and practical project experiences have been shared.
