

Is made up by cooperatives, mutual organisations, economically-active foundations and associations, labour companies, job placement companies, special employment centres, fishermen's guilds and agricultural processing cooperative companies.

The most widespread and traditional social economy model in Catalonia is that of the cooperatives

- Present throughout the territory
- Present in all business sectors
- Accounting for 40% of the social economy (4.215)

46.772 jobs in cooperatives

Turnover of **4.5 billion euros** (2.2% of Catalan GDP)

4.36% jobs increase year-on-year


