

## Catalonia a creative gastronomy HUB

Creativity, a strong culinary tradition and the **huge variety** of local products have put Catalan cuisine firmly on the map of world gastronomy. In the prestigious list of World's 50 Best Restaurants, Catalan restaurants have been ranked number one seven times in the last 15 years.
