- 1. Interregional learning (2018-2020): partners identify and exchange good practices, conduct study visits and incorporate the knowledge into concrete action plans;
- 2. Implementation (2020-2022): partners put into action the knowledge acquired and monitor and report on their results, sharing solutions with other European cities and regions.

- Innovative models for waste collection, prevention and recycling;
- Different models for waste generation fees.
