 - We carry on pedagogical activities about energy saving and understanding of how a solar panel works, for schoolboys and girls, and employees of Lorient City Council






SAS OnCIMè

- Company created in 2015 (106 shareholders today)
- Focused on participative management
- Finances local and fully citizen driven renewable energy production projects
- We have built with the City Council the first projects: they wanted to involve citizens in local energy policy, and wanted to reduce the energy bill.
 We wanted to drive local energy citizen projects.
- Our latest project: we bought the solar power plant, had it set up by a local company, and will rent it for 15 years to the organic food store Biocoop



Our economic model: Self consumption





For the future

- We will merge the society OnCIMè with another local society
- We will make a partnership with Enercoop, which is a cooperative of energy producers
- We are thinking about diversify our production, in wood energy...
