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The Project

*ThreeT seeks to improve the performance of 8 policy instruments to protect and enhance natural and cultural heritage by setting up **thematic trails** or improving existing ones, making them **accessible** to all through **green** modes of transport and readily available information.*

Expected **impacts** on partner territories are:

- New trails established
- Existing trails strengthened
- Improved economic conditions and increased employment opportunities
- Enlarged participative cohesions among institutions and local stakeholders
- New proposed modes of protecting and enhancing natural and historic-cultural assets

Sharing partner experiences

During the period from June to November 2019 the partners, together with their stakeholders, carried on with the planned Study Visits to 4 partner regions: Finland, Poland, Romania and Italy. During each Study Visit a selected number of Good Practices (GP) was inspected and two GP were earmarked for the next planned activity in early 2020 (4 Tutoring sessions between experience transferring and receiving partners).

The official website of Threet project now displays various deliverables for consultation and downloading in the Library section <https://www.interregeurope.eu/threet/library/> : 8 territorial Context Analysis reports, Good Practice initial presentations made by the partners in Romania in March 2019 and the reports summarizing the contents and results of the initial 3 Study Visits.

The Good Practice forms are accessible to partners and stakeholders in the internal project website, where they can be searched using a Search tool based on key words, theme or geographical area or by a Geo Viewer.

As GP contents are being validated and improved with the results originating from the Study Visits, we anticipate that they will be eventually available in the official website by March 2020. The partnership will also select and propose to the Interreg Europe Policy Learning Platform a selection of 10-12 GP to be possibly uploaded in the Platform.



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Study Visit n. 3, Finland

The Study Visit was hosted in Jyväskylä by the partner Regional Council of Central Finland and referred to the following Good Practices: Biogas ecosystem / Sauna Region of the World / Silence as a tourism attraction / ®Meijän polku (Our wellbeing path in the nature) / architect Alvar Aalto routes in Jyväskylä region



Study Visit n. 4 , Poland

The Study Visit was hosted in Toruń and other sites by the partner Kujawsko-Pomorskie Region.

4 Good Practices were presented:

Bory Tucholskie in Labyrinths of Nature / Tourist Passport 2018 / TeH2O Water, Industry and Crafts Trail on industrial heritage / Along the Lower Vistula Fortifications Trail

Study Visit n. 5 , Romania

The Study Visit was hosted by the Self-Government Office of Brasov County and regarded 5 experiences: Transylvanian Highlands / Eco-touristic trail network in Poarta Carpatilor / Thematic Trails within Piatra Craiului National Park / Eco-touristic trail network in Magura Codlea Mountain / Connecting trails between Historical Center and Rasnov Citadel



Study Visit n. 6 , Italy

The Study Visit was hosted by Livorno Province and Tuscany Region in the mainland and in the island of Elba. Good Practices presented are:

Perla 1 & 2 on beach safety and sustainable local transport / Parks & Museums without barriers in Val di Cornia / A sea of citrus fruits brand / Governance models on European project planning and on an integrated local transport system at provincial level
