- Present experience and expertise in the partnership to make action plans and to change policy
- Make simplified template for the Project to collect good practice
- Submit Good Practice to PLP

Work between meetings

- Toolbox development
- Find relevant GPs for study trips
- All good practice collected in to one "folder"
- Good Practice collected on website

- The expert partner collects Good Practice and bring an overview back to the partnership, as a summarised "status of the partnership" on each topic – Benchmark within the partnership
- Develop the grid provided in the first study visit

- Select Good Practice, with the aim to include in to the regions Action Plans
- Each region use the Good Practice that suits their region– work to implement and change policy

Study trips / Site visits

- Present the good practices from all partners
- The host country then show good practice in action – discussions on the topics

- Expert Partner connect OSS Good Practice to relevant other GP in Policy Learning Platform, and to relevant research on the topic.
- Benchmark to other projects in PLP

- Each Region make their Action Plan
- 1 – 3 Good Practice is enough to include
- Need to choose which Good practice to use

WORKSHOP:

- Use the template on Takeaways from Aldershot
- Follow up when partners get home – update the progress and status – send to expert partner

- Outline which partners can benefit from learning from other partners in the partnership, whom and what – closer working relationship

STAKEHOLDERS involved

Communication on study visits: press release and invitation, take good pictures, video interviews stakeholders, stories to tell in regions, be live on Facebook etc during visit

- Select the lessons learnt at the study trip to work towards implementation in their region.
- Present to stakeholders – Regional meetings
- Monthly online status meetings – update each other

Overall goal for the OSS partnership:

End up with 6 Action Plans adjusted to the need of each region, and make policy change and implementation more clear and easy to set in to action
