PAYT, KAYT...



PAYT = schemes that charge waste producer on the basis of the **actual amount of waste generated** and provide **incentives for separation at source** of recyclable waste and for **reduction of mixed waste**.



KAYT = schemes based on diverse **information, communication and nudging actions** to make the **users aware** of their **waste prevention** and **sorting performances**.

But also: “rewarded as you throw”, mixed systems...
