## What Awaits in the Third Semester?

The next project meeting will take place in **October 2020 in Gozo, Malta**. Hosted by the [Ministry for Gozo](#), partners will meet to share the project progress and plan the next steps. An international workshop will present collated examples of best practices and select the most interesting and representative ones to be later uploaded [on the Interreg Europe Policy Learning Platform](#). The project partners from MGOZ are preparing a study visit to [Magro Food](#), which has an installed photovoltaic system. The participating partners and stakeholders will learn more about the use of this type of renewable in industry.



Other activities in semester 3 will include further regional meetings of stakeholders and internal meetings. Each partner should have completed an analysis of the RES market in their countries/regions. The analysis will be the basis for Regional Assessments and later down the line to some extent reflected in future Action Plans.
