Heritage can help rebuild communities. But how?

Challenges within communities

- Reluctancy to volunteer – communist legacy
- Huge personal workload – agriculture and subsistence
- Poor communities, lacking basic infrastructure
- Lack of initiative & knowledge on heritage protection
- > 16.000 heritage sites

However ...

- People are moving (back) to rural areas
- Heritage grassroots initiatives are growing
- The impact of COVID19

Emergency conservation works for endangered heritage sites

- Link between students, heritage professionals, craftsmen and communities
- Strong local stakeholder engagement and involvement
- Adopted and implemented by several NGOs across Romania
- Faced COVID challenges successfully

Private investment in heritage

- Downscaling couple
- Revived an abandoned manor
- Involved & employed the local community
- Focused on local attractions (places, people)
- Catalyst for innovation in cultural tourism in the area
- COVID innovation – butler app & safe zone



Adopt a House in Roșia Montană

NGO initiative for a mining cultural landscape

- Grew when local heritage was threatened by a large scale mining project.
- Link between students, professionals, craftsmen, funders and local community (owners)
- Schooled an entire generation of heritage activists
- COVID effects – less students, longer stays, more online visibility (podcast)



In a nutshell ...

Heritage is helping rebuild rural communities in Romania

- Grassroots projects are growing in numbers
- Media coverage and public interest is growing
- Young professionals have a wider variety of training possibilities
- Ideas on the benefits of heritage are slowly making their way into public policies

What about COVID19?

- Project teams shifted to helping communities stay safe
- Communities showed more resilience
- Sparked innovation and fueled cohesion to keep ongoing projects relevant and running
- Increased interest in remote work and downscaling
