ABOUT THE PROJECT

Delta regions are rich in biodiversity but poor financially. The challenge is how to **foster the natural and cultural capabilities** and **develop new experiences** based on **ecosystem services** to boost regional economy.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE

Delta Lady aims at **improving the regional policy instruments** for sustainable nature, culture and economy **in river deltas**. To boost regional economy, the project intends to foster the capabilities of **using ecosystem services** based on local natural and cultural qualities.

Province of Fryslân (NL) wants to introduce innovative aspect in the Northern Innovation Agenda to foster diverse economic developments in the delta region.

The Regional Natural Park of Camargue (FR) wants to introduce ecosystem services in the Charter of Commitment of the Park.

Danube Delta NI for Research & Development (RO) will make specific reference to the use of ecosystem services to achieve objectives in the Regional Operational Programme.

Po Delta Park and ART-ER (IT) want to integrate mechanisms of Payments for Ecosystem Services and promote shared solutions in the Park's Territorial Plan.

Council of Chambers of Commerce of the Valencia Region (ES) aims to improve the Regional Operational Program to accomplish the Territorial Strategy of the Valencia Region for 2030.

Cork County Council and University College Cork (IE) want to ensure incorporation of ecosystem services at regional (RSES) & local policy (Cork County Development Plan) levels.
