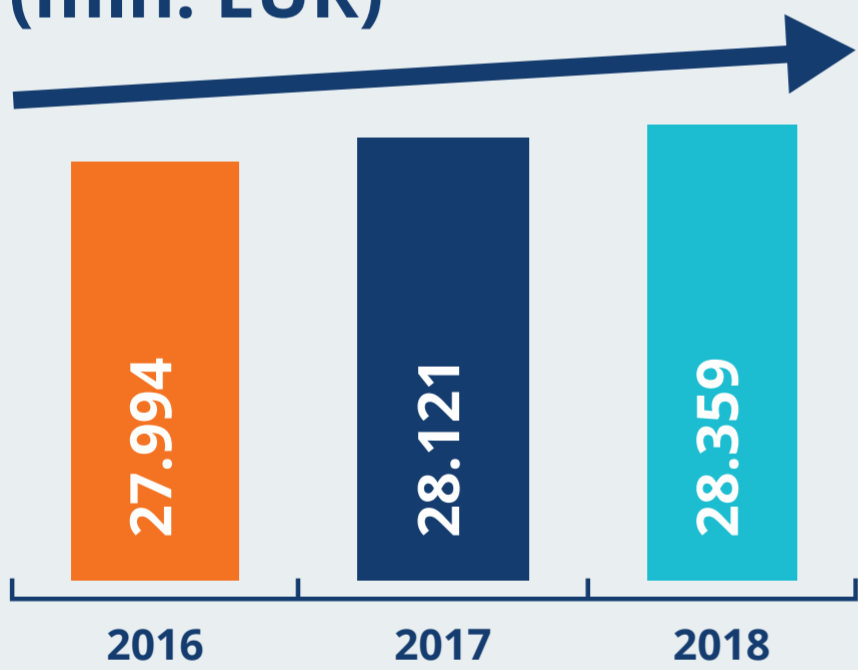

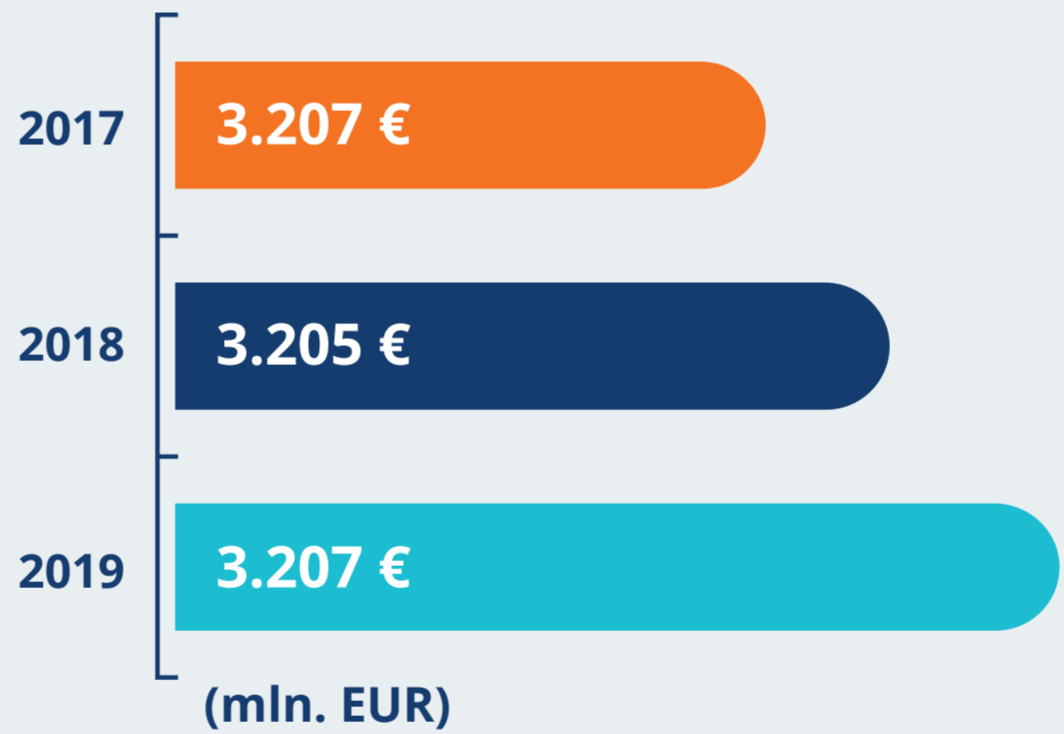

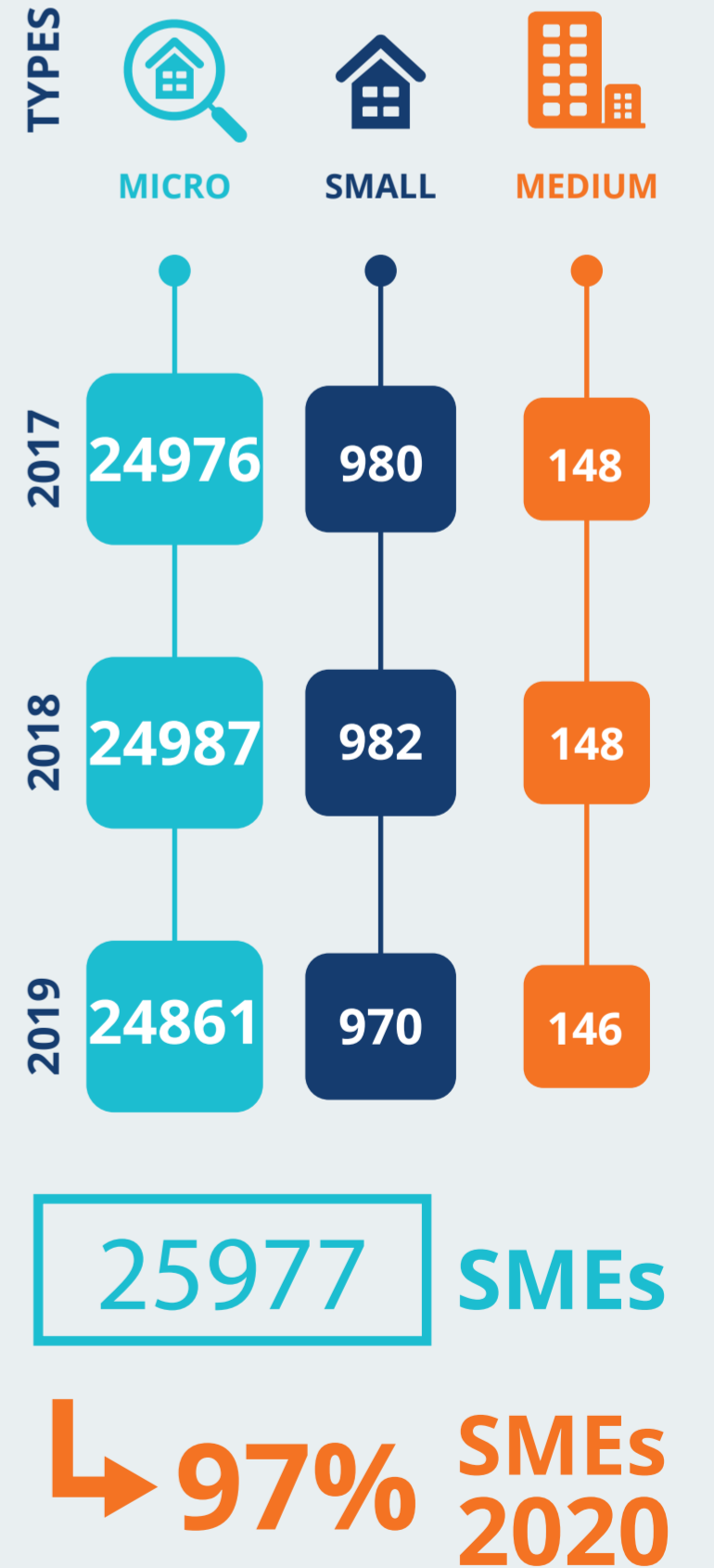
GDP IN THE REGION (mln. EUR)
