The Royal Castle in Checiny was built on the ridge of a rocky hill (367 m above sea level), at the turn of the 13th and 14th centuries.

The fortress was a high-ranking object, a centre of political life, where the congresses of noblemen and knights were convened.

The fortress has also served as a prison since the end of the 14th century.

- ➤ The castle was the residence of royal families, queens and widows.
- During the Zebrzydowski's rebellion in 1607, the castle was significantly damaged.
- ➤ In 1610, the starost of Chęciny and crown swordsman Stanisław Branicki renovated the castle, partly extending it.
- ➤ In the era of the Swedish 'Deluge', the fortress in Checiny was destroyed and rebuilt.
- After the Third Partition of Poland the castle started to fall into ruin.
- The castle walls suffered greatly as a result of the activity of the local people, who obtained material for building from here and from artillery fire during the First World War.

- ➤ The first conservation work on the castle ruins was already carried out in the 1880`s
- ➤ In 1947, the provincial conservator entered the ruins in the register of monuments and classified it in the first, highest group in the country.
- As a result of further work, carried out between 1948 and 1949, the castle towers were renovated. All the time, works were carried out to protect the object as "permanent ruin".
- ➤ Until 2010, the Royal Castle in Checiny was leased to a private entity.
- ➤ Since 2011 the Royal Castle in Checiny has been managed by the Municipality and the City of Checiny.
- ➤ In 2014, an Organisational Unit of the Checiny Commune and Town, called the Royal Castle in Checiny, was established to manage the ruins.
- ➤ Until 2015, a project was carried out, as part of which a comprehensive revitalization of the Castle and the Castle Hill was carried out.



# The Royal Castle in Checiny - before renovation



- > The castle was neglected.
- ➤ The tourist traffic did not bring the expected financial results.
- > The walls of the Castle fell into complete ruin.
- ➤ The tourist facilities in Checiny were negligible.

#### **Project title:**

"The Royal Castle in Checiny - a historic place of the power of the Świętokrzyskie Land - complex development of the Castle Hill and organization of a supra-regional event "Siege of the Checiny Fortress"

The project was co-financed within the framework of the Regional Operational Programme of the Świętokrzyskie Region for 2007-2013; Priority Axis 2 - Support for innovation, building an information society and increasing investment potential of the region; Measure 2.3 - Economic and tourist promotion of the region.

The revitalization of the Royal Castle in Checiny cost nearly <u>PLN 8 milion</u> <u>/approx. 1,8 mln Euro/</u>, of which PLN 6.5 million was financed by the municipal authorities from EU funds. The own contribution of the Municipality and the City of Checiny was PLN 1.6 million.

#### As a result of the project:

- The treasury and the castle chapel were renovated.
- ➤ A square tower (western tower) was made available for tourist traffic.
- > The Castle Hill has been tidied up.
- The car park and the roads leading to the castle were rebuilt, with numerous carved figures connected with the history of the town.
- > An interesting light illumination was installed.
- > A medieval well was rebuilt.




#### As a result of the project:






In order to meet the expectations of the inhabitants of the Checiny Commune and tourists, we conduct promotional activities in a wide range.

- We have an interesting offer of visiting the Castle, which we adjust to the seasons, type of tourists or current events.









Number of tourists in the Castle in particular years:





The scheme of management in the Royal Castle






We have adjusted the tours of the Castle to the rules of the relevant legal acts related to the maintenance of safety rules:

- **✓ We have introduced a one-way tour**
- ✓ In enclosed spaces, tourists are required to cover their mouth and nose
- ✓ Hand disinfectants are available
- ✓ Tourists shall be informed of the obligation to maintain the required distance
- ✓ We prefer non-contact forms of payment
- ✓ We monitor the Ministry of Health's announcements and update the guidelines for observing security rules at the Castle in connection with the pandemic on an ongoing basis
- ✓ Castle employees were obliged to cover their nose and face with a mask or visor, use disposable gloves, regularly disinfect their hands and keep an appropriate distance





### The Royal Castle in Checiny during the epidemic HOLIDAY'S END





















- ➤ Because of COVID-19, the year 2020 is very difficult for tourist traffic. During the closure period, i.e. from 12 March to 16 May 2020, tourism services were not provided
- As a result of a gradual process of loosening of sanitary restrictions, in May and June, tourist traffic grew steadily, to reach even higher values in the following months than those recorded in the same period a year earlier.
- This is certainly the result of the continuous work of the team, which does not give up and constantly watches over the quality of services provided by the Royal Castle in Checiny.

The Royal Castle in Checiny, due to its open-air character, is the place where tourists are more likely to stay during the COVID 19 period.
