The stakeholder group meeting was a dissemination event, organized on behalf of Dom na Krasu. Dom na Krasu provides institutional care for adults with long-term mental health problems. Dom is currently involved in the process of deinstitutionalisation, with ambitious plan to move 70 residents from the institution back into the community. UNI LJ connected Dom na Krasu with Telekom Slovenije and University Medical Centre in Ljubljana, which presented e-care and especially e-health services currently available in Slovenia. A good practice, currently tested in long-term care pilots, also implemented based on the Liverpool ITHACA good practice, was presented, as well as other smart care and health solutions, currently available in Slovenia. These new ICT solutions are being considered for new placements for people with mental health problems. The meeting was held online, via Zoom.
