Description:

In Semester 3, partners conclude the regional analyses of their public policies. They initiate Step 3 of the Methodology Document to match regional Policy Needs with Good Practices proposed by partners. During the semester, exchange continues, to ensure that the final set of GPs and experiences respond to partners' requests.

The Virtual Meeting aims to:

- Present results from the Matching Analysis to demonstrate needs, identified GPs and gaps. Other partners are asked to propose any further GPs/experiences.
- Familiarise partners with upcoming activities (e.g. GPs exchange, peer-reviewing, Action Plan development).
- Discuss early Policy Improvement exchanges.

Preparation:

- All partners should prepare the Matching Analysis table, send it to the LP / Resolvo (who will make it available on Trello) and be ready to present it at the session.
- All partners should have a look at other partners' Matching Analysis table and be ready to make suggestions for further experiences / exchange, on the basis of the gaps identified.

Partners present the analysis carried out with regional stakeholders, describing the identified Policy Needs, GPs already addressing those needs, and additional experiences missing to meet the Needs. The presentation should be made using the Matching Analysis form, which partners have had access to before the meeting.

Following each presentation, partners discuss possibly available GPs/experiences to be proposed in order to bridge the gaps. Keep your presentation as short as possible to leave time for discussion / Q&A.
