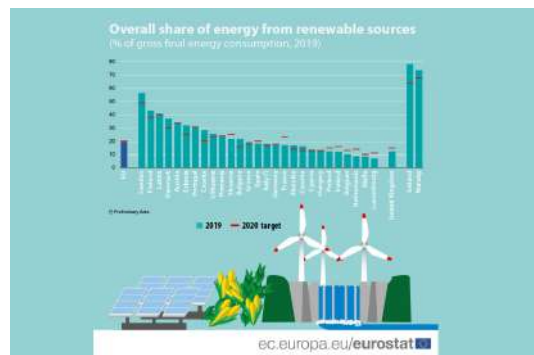

What can we expect during the fourth semester?

Due to the current situation and the restrictions generated by the COVID pandemic, RESINDUSTRY Consortium has decided to celebrate the next online meeting

The next Steering Committee will be held on Wednesday February 3, 2021 to plan project activities. Partners will discuss the progress on the Regional Assessment, which will be the basis for the Action Plan.

The Interregional Workshop 4 will be managed by [Marshall Office of Świętokrzyskie Region](#) on February 23, 2021; also held online. It will be focused on the Regional Assessment task.

Given the travel restrictions all around Europe, it is expected that the Study Visit 4 will have to be postponed, as was the case with Study Visit 3.

But the work of RESINDUSTRY project does not stop because of coronavirus crisis. Fortunately, there are still many project activities that can be implemented, even if the format has to be adapted. These are the upcoming activities in the following semester:

- **Policy Breakfasts**: It consists of breakfast meetings in each region with Policy representatives to present the Regional Assessment results and the conclusions of the Interregional Workshop 4. A discussion on draft activities to be included in the regional Action Plan is foreseen.
- **Expert Missions**: Based on the selected Best Practices, partners will require the mission of one expert from the institution which provided the Best Practice. The Expert will provide tailor-made training based on the request of the institution receiving the expert.
