

How do we make the Discovery?

Castilla y León University System

- 9 Universities (4 public/5 private),
- 16 campuses.
- Number of students: 82.423 (5,4% of nacional amount).
- Teaching and Research staff: 7.703 (6,4% of the national rate).
- University degrees: 257 (6,8% of the nacional rate).

EDP ACTION "University-Business Challenge"

- Who participates?



- Coordinated by the Regional Ministry for Education through FUESCYL (Universities and Higher Education Foundation of Castilla y León).
- Officially launched in 2008
- Contributions to the S3 during the "strategy definition stage":
 - To strengthen links between University and Business by promoting entrepreneurship and innovation culture at the University
 - To incorporate knowledge as an asset of the regional economy
 - To establish a regional higher education partnership/network to better understand the regional situation and overcome the barriers
 - To enhance a continuous and strategic collaboration among regional universities

"University-Business Challenge"



• Main objectives:

- Identify challenges and opportunities of the regional socio-economic tissue
- Promote knowledge transfer through innovative projects by giving solutions to the challenges previously identified
- Enable future cooperation between the different regional agents

Quadruple helix engagement:

- Society participates by the proposal of challenges
- Companies and entrepreneurs by the proposal of challenges
- Universities participate giving technological answers
- Public Administration coordinating, enhancing and financing the whole process
- The university-business challenge has two different tools:
 - An annual contest provided with different awards and promoted by FUESCYL
 - Different calls for collaborative projects organised by the regional universities
- As a result since 2013 the "University-Business Challenge Contest" has identified and executed more than 130 regional R&D collaborative projects





Aftermath of the discovery

TCUE Network Impact and Results (2008-2018)

INDICATOR	Before TCUE Network (annual average)	2008-2018 (annual average)
Universities turnover from RTD transfer	11,631,051	15,369,072
Annual number of new companies emerged from universities (spinoff included)	5.0	23.09
Universities patent applications at national level	8.67	33.91
Universities licensed patents	2.67	6.64



Beyond discovery:

- Through BEYOND EDP project we have better focused on challenges and collaboration between universities and business, enriched with the vision provided by partners
- We are at present running an action on the entrepreneurial discovery process applied to the S3 challenge of economic opportunities in rural areas in Castilla y León:
 - We are implementing of a <u>participative and interactive process</u> among the different agents of the region to discover potential new activities enhancing the rural regional economy
 - This participative process is supported on digital tools
 - In the following months we will scale this action to the rest of the potential priorities of the future Castilla y León S3
