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# The Regional council and the BFC region

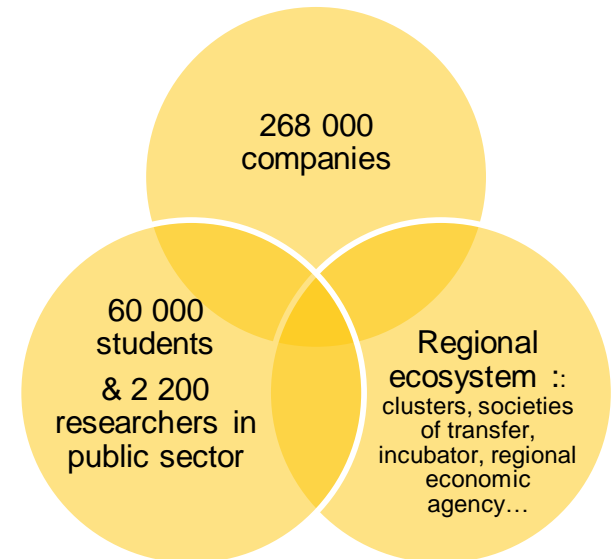
- **The Regional Council of Bourgogne-Franche-Comté**

- Regional authority
  - Managing authority of ERDF funds
  - In charge of the design, implementation and monitoring of the S3
- 6 regional domains of excellence identified :
1. *Sustainable food*
  2. *Health, individualized and integrated care*
  3. *Smart and connected mobility*
  4. *Hydrogen*
  5. *Advanced materials and processes*
  6. *Microtechnology and smart systems*

- **Bourgogne-Franche-Comté region**

- A French region located in East of the France
- 2.8 millions inhabitants
- First industrial region in France



# Mimedi, an innovative collaborative project

- The MiMédi project aims at proposing new fabrication concepts (MiMédi: French acronym for “Microtechniques pour les médicaments innovants”). The goal is to associate competences in microfabrication and know-how in tomorrow’s personalized medicine.
- Mimédi was launched in January 2018 for a 4 years duration.
- The MiMédi project involves 10 regional partners : 6 companies, 3 laboratories and 1 transfer body
- Global amount : 13.6 M€, funded by ERDF funds for an amount of 10M€ (75%)



# Mimedi, an innovative collaborative projet

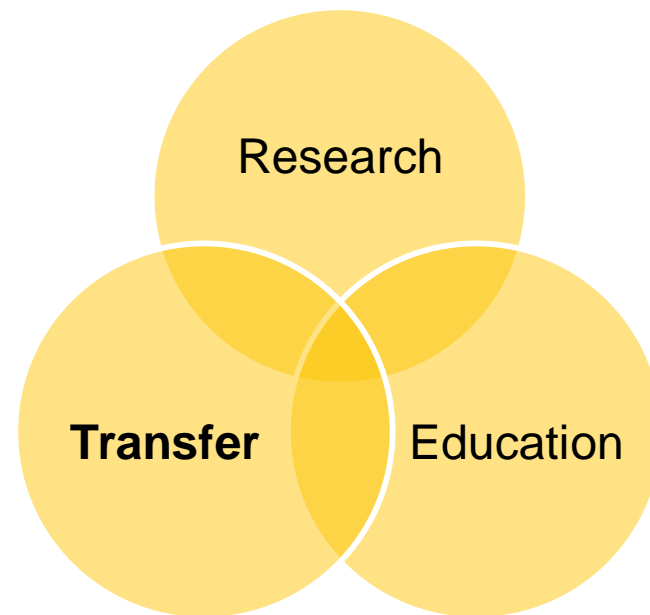
## Regional impacts :

- Scientific interest : development of innovative medicines
- Economic interest :
  - Structuring of the health sector in region, from manufacture of Medi until the market ;
  - Involvement of 6 SMEs ;
  - Job creation ; creation of start-ups, an increase in turnover
  - Crossroad between historical skills in region (microtechnology) and health ;
- Technical and financial support of public sector
- Evolution of the S3 : health sector was not in the initial priority areas, appeared opportunity



# Conclusions

- Innovating by promoting the results of public research is an imperative for the economic growth of territories.
- Transfer knowledge research to further development for industrial and commercial purposes.
- Valorisation and transfer can take different forms.
- Challenge : increase the partnerships between higher education institutions and economic world
  - Role of intermediates bodies like clusters, transfer agency...
