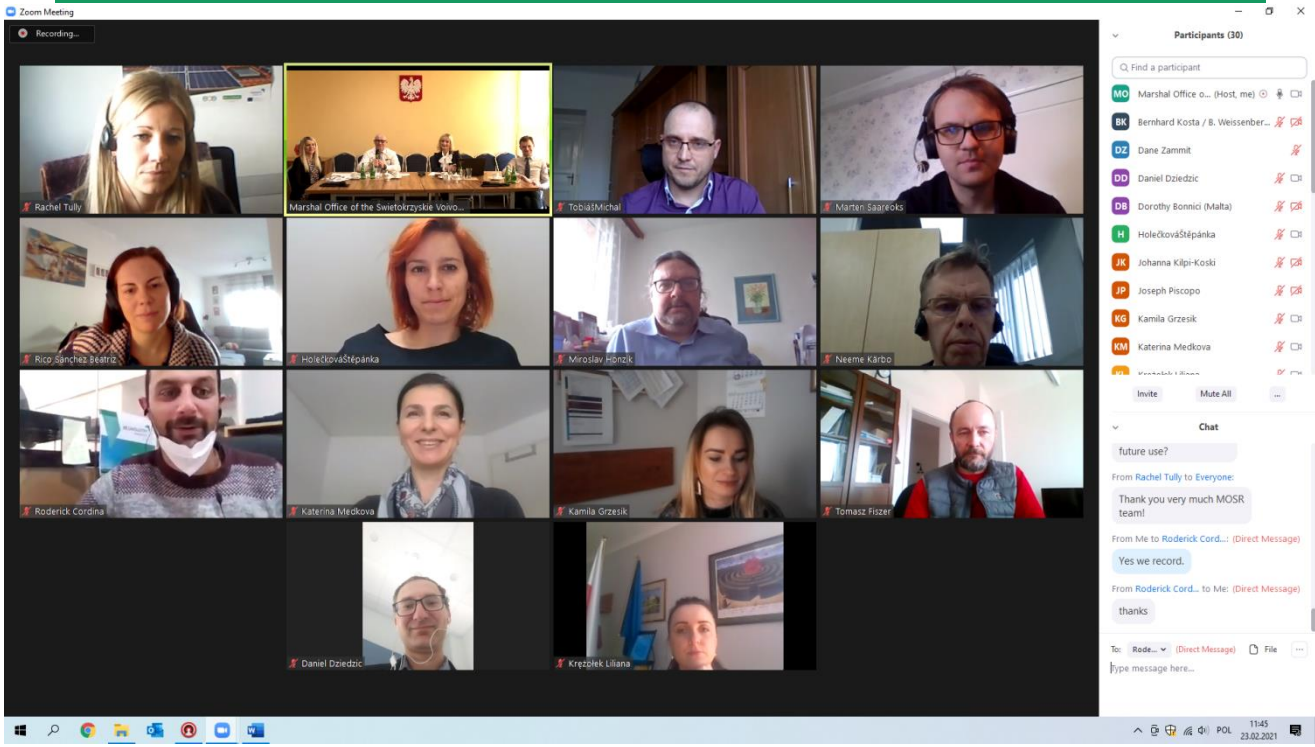

## Interregional Workshop 4 Summary

---

### **The RESINDUSTRY project and the new EU perspective**

**Interregional Workshop 4, 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2021, attended by the RESINDUSTRY international partners, was devoted to the draft contract of support proposed by the European Commission in the new EU financial perspective 2021–2027.**

The meeting, organised by the Office of the Marshal of the Świętokrzyskie Voivodeship, was attended by international representatives of the RESINDUSTRY project partners, among them the Czech Technical University in Prague, University Centre for Energy Efficient Buildings, the LAB University of Applied Sciences in Finland, the Extremadura Energy Agency in Spain, the Regional Energy Agency in Tartu in Estonia, Vorarlberg University of Applied Sciences in Austria and the Ministry of Gozo in the Republic of Malta. The foreign partners were accompanied by their stakeholders during the workshop.

It is worth noting that the Świętokrzyskie stakeholders of the RESINDUSTRY project also connected remotely, including Academy of Entrepreneurship LTD sp. z o.o., Regional Centre for Innovation and Technology Transfer sp. z o.o., EkoEnergia sp. z o.o., Regional Science and Technology Centre, Verdo Energy Systems sp. z o.o., the Municipal Service Management Company in Końskie sp. z o.o., Energy Consulting Trade-Off. There were 43 participants registered altogether.

The main part of the conference was devoted to the support proposed by the European Commission in the new financial perspective 2021 - 2027. Mrs Anna Kucharczyk, Deputy Director of the Department of Investments and Development, presented the assumptions for the project *Development Strategy for the Świętokrzyskie Voivodeship 2030+*, she also presented the objectives of the financial policy in the new EU perspective.

“The RESINDUSTRY project plays a very important role in the consultation on, in particular, objective 2 of the Cohesion Policy “*A more environmentally friendly, emission-free Europe,*” said Anna Kucharczyk.

During the meeting, the demarcation line and the draft Partnership Agreement - documents defining the principles of dividing investment financing between programmes implemented at the



national and regional levels - were also discussed. Particular attention was paid to the types of projects related to renewable energy and energy efficiency intended for micro and small companies and subject to co-financing under the European Regional Development Fund.

An important topic of the workshop was key solutions in the application of renewable energy sources in partner regions. Dr. Tomasz Fiszer, an expert of the Office of the Marshal of the Świętokrzyskie Voivodeship (MOSR), presented international partners with instructions and suggestions on collecting data on the potential of regions in the use of renewable energy. He presented important principles of supplementing the regional evaluation template with data available in partner countries. Information in these templates, such as, types and the share of energy sources used in industry, the planned reduction of emissions by 2030, the capacity of RES installations in industries significant to a given region, and many others, will allow to determine the profile of a given area and indicate opportunities and ways to support the development of renewable energy in industry.
